1. 1917 DWM NAVAL, 9mm 6" barrel, 2 position sight. 1917 over chamber, on left of frame and front sight block. 90% original blue, 75% straw. Bore VG. Excellent light colored grips typical of the period. Matching Naval proofed magazine without concentric rings. \$350.00
2. 1914 ERFURT MILITARY, 9mm 4" barrel. 1914 over chamber. Crown Erfurt on forward toggle. 98% original blue, 98% original straw. Erfurts of this period have a very smooth rich blue in contrast to the later ones that have rough tool marks. Exc. bore, perfect dark walnut matching grips. Erfurt proofed magazine has no number. A near perfect military.
3. 1914 ERFURT ARTILLERY, 9mm 8" barrel, 8 position rear sight. Fine tuning on front and rear sights. Bore VG-Exc. 96% original blue and straw. Exc. dark walnut matching grips. Magazine does not match. Items 2 and 3 as a pair \$550.00
4. 1900 SWISS with WIDE TRIGGER. 7.65mm 4 3/4" barrel. Swiss Cross in Sunburst over chamber. Bore perfect. Swiss magazine has metal inserts. 98% blue and straw. Just a little wear on the straps. Perfect original walnut grips. Trigger is full width of guard as mentioned in Jones book. No release date. Trigger pull is terrific. \$500.00
5. 1906 SWISS MILITARY. 7.65mm 4 3/4" barrel. Cross in Sunburst over chamber. 98% blue and straw - just a little dulling on front strap. Mint bore. Exc. walnut grips. P 51 release date. \$450.00
6. 1906 SWISS POLICE. 7.65mm 4 3/4" barrel. Cross in Shield over chamber. 95% blue, 80% straw. Mint bore. A moderate amount of spotting on front strap and a little freckling on the rear. Exc. dark walnut grips. No release date. \$450.00
7. 1924 BERN SWISS. 7.65mm 4 3/4" barrel. Smooth bordered checkered walnut grips. P 49 release date. Waffenfabrik Bern on forward toggle. Factory New condition in and out. \$500.00
8. 1929 SWISS MILITARY. 7.65mm 4 3/4" barrel. Cross in Shield on forward toggle. 97% blue. Just a little blue wear on top of goggle knobs and side-plate hump. Perfect black plastic grips. Mint bore. No release date. \$475.00

9. SIMSON & CO. 9mm 4" barrel. 1916 on chamber, Simson & Co. Suhl on toggle. An abundance of Simson and Erfurt proof marks. Apparently made from surplus Erfurt parts. Bore VG. Walnut grips good. 70% original blue remains but is somewhat dull and discolored. \$125.00
10. 1923 SAFE & LOADED. 3 7/8" 7.65mm barrel. 99% reblue with all corners and curves perfect. 90% straw. Exc. bore, exc. walnut grips. A hard to find variation for only \$150.00
11. 1908 DWM COMMERCIAL. 9mm 4" barrel. All matching, 95% original blue 60% straw. Freckling on grip straps. Blue wear at muzzle and sideplate hump. BUG proofs. Made without holdopen. Exc. walnut grips. Bore fair \$200.00
12. 22 Cal. Experimental Converted Luger with 6" barrel. This conversion is identical with the one shown in Dstig's "THE LUGER PISTOL", except for barrel length. (See pages 268, 279, photos 275, 276) This piece began as a 42 Code 1939 Military. Gun was re-blued when converted - has 90% finish. Mint bore. Good walnut grips. Oberndorf proof on front sight block. A most intriguing and rare variation. We had this one before but since we just re-acquired it in a collection we can offer it for only \$395.00
13. 1914 DWM ARTILLERY. 8" 9mm barrel. 95% blue with just a little wear on the sideplate hump and muzzle. 70% straw. Exc. walnut grips. VG bore. Fine tuning front and rear sights. \$325.00
14. 1915 DWM ARTILLERY. 8" 9mm barrel. 95% blue with moderate freckling. 70% straw. BG walnut grips. VG bore. Fine tuning front and rear sights. \$295.00
15. 1906 DUTCH. 9mm 4" barrel. 90% blue (just a little bit dull). 80% straw. Coarse checkered grips are excellent. Brass plate marked - 3 - INF - II 16  
Rust with arrow pointing up at safety lever. Has original dutch magazine. Geladen on both sides of extractor. 1916 barrel date. Wilhelmina proof on receiver. This very piece pictured in "Lugers Unlimited" by F. G. Tilton. \$475.00
16. 1906 type DUTCH. Numbered after RAF (?) contract. 9mm 4" barrel. Grip-safety, Rust with arrow pointing up at safety lever. Long barrel band with set-back sight block similar to early K Date indicating 1934 manufacture Receiver has Oberndorf proof although toggle is DWM. Numbering is quite small similar to K Date. Very large lanyard loop. 85% blue, 50% straw. VG grips. Bore VG. Breechblock has Naval proof but is numbered to gun. Mis-matched firing pin. This piece also pictured and described in "Lugers Unlimited". A very Rare Luger. \$550.00
17. An early snail drum magazine in excellent condition with an excellent plus Loading tool. The set for \$250.00
