

FIREARMS LICENSE (FFL) is required on all shipments of modern guns. We must wait for a signed-in-ink copy from your dealer before we can ship to him. Pre-1898 firearms and non-firearms items exempt.

SHIPPING Please include sufficient shipping and insurance costs. We will ship via UPS, but must have your dealer's STREET ADDRESS. We try to ship your order within 2 business days after we receive your cashiers check or money order or credit card information and signed FFL copy.

PAYMENT Cashiers check or money order is preferred! Personal checks delay orders at least 14 days while check clears. VISA, MASTERCARD, and AMERICAN EXPRESS card orders are welcome on orders over \$25. Be advised that refunds made by credit card take extra time to process!

ILLINOIS RESIDENTS must include 7% sales tax. No exceptions: Send us a copy of your resale tax number if you are exempt.
