## TERMS OF SALE & GENERAL INFORMATION

**GUARANTEE** Your satisfaction is guaranteed, however, no guarantee is made with respect to safety of firing condition. Any undamaged item may be returned within 10 days for full refund less shipping & handling. But you must contact us immediately if any items are to be returned.

**SHIPPING** Include sufficient additional funds for shipping & insurance costs. UPS is the preferred method & normally requires a street address. Orders shipped within 48 hours.

**PAYMENT** in US Dollars may be made in any form; it is inadvisable to send cash by mail. Personal checks may delay shipment 14 days if we do not know you. VISA & MASTERCARD are both accepted with \$100.00 minimum order; give us your full account number & the expiration date of your charge card. This may be done by letter or telephone.

**FIREARMS** cannot be shipped until we have a current, signed in ink, copy of the required Federal Firearms License (FFL) for shipment of modern arms within the USA. This does not apply to 'antiques' and other 'non-firearms'.

**EXPORT** The terms stated herein do not generally apply to export sales. Please request a copy of our Export Quotation for details.

**CALIFORNIA RESIDENTS** must add 6% sales tax. Or, if you have a Calif. Resale Number, send a completed resale card in-lieu-of the sales tax. There can be no exceptions.

**INQUIRIES & TRADES** We try to answer your letters promptly, but are often delayed. Your stamped, self-addressed envelope (SSAE) will facilitate a timely response & be appreciated too! Please describe any trade items, specify each's value, suggesting a trade.

**PHONE CALLS** are appropriate to reserve, temporarily, any items you wish to purchase. Remember we are located in the Pacific Time Zone, and time your calls accordingly. If no one answers, please call again in an hour. NORMAL HOURS 9AM-6PM. UNLESS EMERGENCY!

**LAYAWAYS** require 20% deposit (\$20.00 minimum) & reserve any items up to 30 days. Full payment is due then or the deposit is normally forfeit & no returns can be made on layaway sales. Periods of more than 30 days are possible if agreed to in writing in advance by you and by us in specific terms. This must be discussed by phone.

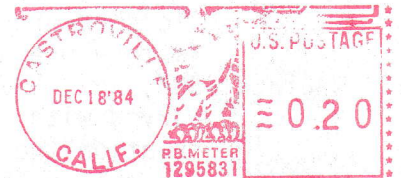
- . FRENCH "UNIQUE RANGER", .22 cal., 398XXX range; similar to last item but with external hammer & in the much scarcer .22 cal; with torn & tattered box, pistol is virtually 100% mint; a scarcer variation, seldom seen; priced at \$200
- 56. FRENCH "UNIQUE" Model "L", .380 cal., 653XXX range; another smaller 'Unique' product of the postwar era; with original box (torn), brochure/instructions, & certificate; retains about 98% blue except for fading gripstraps; (see Mathews, p.414-II) \$175
- 57. HAWES "DIPLOMAT", .380 cal., 003XXX range; more commonly seen as a 'Sterling' PPL, this is an interesting small pistol which resembles Hi-Standards with external hammer and short barrel & grip, resulting in a pocket .380 type; 99%+ mint & scarce!! \$250
- 58. HIGH STANDARD "SUPERMATIC TOURNAMENT" M106, .22 cal., 191XXXX range; 5½" heavy barrel, with fluted 7¼" spare barrel; also spare mag. & factory box; terrific quality target pistol which is similar to Colt Gov't .45 Auto in handling; nearly 99%+ mint! \$365
- 59. HUNGARIAN "37M", 9mmK., 144XXX range; fine quality prewar pocket size copy of the Gov't .45 basically; except for some very minor frosting, retains 98% fine blue; bore strong but a bit dark; exc. original grips & perfect mechanically; exc!! \$200
- 60. JO-LO-AR M1924, 9mm/.380 cal., 21XXX range; bright bore & mechanically exc., this 'one hand' pistol has seen much handling & finish is faded, but surfaces generally smooth & markings all sharp; grips chipped at tops; overall about 'vg' & interesting! \$125
- 61. KIMBALL .30 CALIBER CARBINE, 10X range; from the actual production period that includes only some 130 pieces, this example is pristine, 100% perfect and comes with the factory box (box is complete but has been repaired); a rare specimen of its type!! \$1250
- 62. KOMMER, 7.65mm, 14XXX range; from Zella-Mehlis with EAGLE/N commercial proofing of the WWII period, this is a scarce & seldom seen type which is basically a copy of the FN Browning M1910; 96-98% thin, original finish with exc. grips, fading at gripstrap area; (see Mathews, p.384-II); exc. example for the WWII pistol collector! \$345
- 63. LAHTI, 9mmP., 67XXX HUSQVARNA range; Crown/SS proofs at rear & "Rplt.SXXX" control number on right side; perfect bore & brownish grips; 97-98% fine blue; exc+ example \$325
- 64. LUGER, 9mm, DWM 1912, 5XXX range; no stock lug or hold-open device ever present; all match except exc. woodbase mag; bright, exc. bore; beautiful 'straw' colors appear 100% (perhaps restrawed, but if so a most professional job!) lovely grips are exc. too! about 98% blue with a dull/lustreless effect on gripstraps & some hints of frost here and there; overall an exc+ example of the first dated DWM types! \$850
- 65. LUGER, SIMSON, 9mm, 12XX range; Simson mag. sn. is 624; unit markings on gripstrap are "13./J.R.38.13"; fine grips showing normal use/wear; smooth finish, retaining about 80% original blue; small chips face of bolt; worthy of restoration or as is too! \$795
- 66. LUGER, DWM WWII COMMERCIAL REWORK, 9mm, 24XXa range; EAGLE/N proofs abound; large "A" under barrel with 'Fahrman' also there; overall 97% blue & straw; scarce variation so seldom seen its nor often recognized; similar to VONO/ANSCHUTZ rework; \$850
- 67. LUGER, "byf 41", 9mm; all matching with exc. checkered wood grips & bore is mirror bright! correct 'fxo' magazine also exc; retains 97-98% blue; overall exc++ & crisp! \$700
- 68. LUGER, "MAUSER" "42", 7.65mmPara./ .30 Luger cal; no other marks whatsoever, but believed to possibly be a sample for the Swedish market; perfect bore, exc. grips & magazine; straw parts smooth & only slightly fading; excetp for smooth, faded gripstraps, retains about 98% quality, original blue; fascinating variation & rare!! \$2000
- 69. LUGER, MAUSER "PARABELLUM", 7.65mmPara., Swiss Pattern; 6" bbl; test target and all extras in factory box; appears virtually 100% mint with only wear to box; superb! \$600
- 70. LUGER, MAUSER "PARABELLUM", 9mm, Swiss Pattern; 6" bbl; in box with spares, but box is mismatches; almost 100% mint and another lovely example of the type! \$500
- 71. LUGER, MAUSER "PARABELLUM", 9mm, Swiss Pattern; 4" bbl; appears virtually 100% mint in its original box with all spares & papers; superb example of the short version! \$600
- 72. LUGER, MAUSER "PARABELLUM", 7.65mmPara, "P08" Pattern; 6" bbl; pistol is again 100% mint & comes with original box & all extras (spare mag., tool, rod, & papers); \$800
- 73. MBA "GYROJET", 13mm, B2XX range; nickel plated in large wood presentation case as issued by the factory & including 10 dummy 'Rockets' & a medallion celebrating the first rocket by Goddard ca.1926; overall exc., with much handling to case; \$625
- 74. MBA "GYROJET", 12mm, 5XX range; the later Model 'C' of the Mark II series (above is Mark I Model 'B'); this example appears to be nearly 100% mint, as new! \$300
- 75. MAKAROV, 9mmM., ca. 1968; bore nearly perfect, as is 1-piece reddish-brown grip; grip is checkered with 'star' pattern; except for one rub mark, 95% lovely blue; \$1200

  - h. MAUSER "BROOMHANDLE" WOOD HOLSTER-STOCK; original Mauser make in about vg condition \$300
  - i. MAUSER "SCHNELLFEUER" WOOD HOLSTER-STOCK; complete, solid, & 'dinged up'; but scarce!!! \$650
  - j. STAR Model "M"(?); prewar example without deep hole for extended bbl; nice clean example with no damage, but has normal 'dings' & handling marks; vg+ to near exc! \$500
