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TERMS OF SALE & GENERAL INFORMATION

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GUARANTEE Your satisfaction is guaranteed, however, no guarantee is made with respect to safety of firing condition. Any undamaged item may be returned within 10 days for full refund less shipping & handling. But you must contact us immediately if any items are to be returned.

SHIPPING Include sufficient additional funds for shipping & insurance costs. UPS is the preferred method & normally requires a street address. Orders shipped within 48 hours.

PAYMENT in US Dollars may be made in any form; it is inadvisable to send cash by mail. Personal checks may delay shipment 14 days if we do not know you. VISA & MASTERCARD are both accepted with \$100.00 minimum order; give us your full account number & the expiration date of your charge card. This may be done by letter or telephone.

FIREARMS cannot be shipped until we have a current, signed in ink, copy of the required Federal Firearms License (FFL) for shipment of modern arms within the USA. This does not apply to 'antiques' and other 'non-firearms'.

EXPORT The terms stated herein do not generally apply to export sales. Please request a copy of our Export Quotation for details.

CALIFORNIA RESIDENTS must add 6% sales tax. Or, if you have a Calif. Resale Number, send a completed resale card in-lieu-of the sales tax. There can be no exceptions.

INQUIRIES & TRADES We try to answer your letters promptly, but are often delayed. Your stamped, self-addressed envelope (SSAE) will facilitate a timely response & be appreciated too! Please describe any trade items, specify each's value, suggesting a trade.

PHONE CALLS are appropriate to reserve, temporarily, any items you wish to purchase. Remember we are located in the Pacific Time Zone, and time your calls accordingly. If no one answers, please call again in an hour. NORMAL HOURS 9AM-6PM UNLESS EMERGENCY!

LAYAWAYS require 20% deposit (\$20.00 minimum) & reserve any items up to 30 days. Full payment is due then or the deposit is normally forfeit & no returns can be made on layaway sales. 81. ISARD, 9mm, 00002XX range; large Spanish type which is virtually unknown! slide marked "ISARD" " Cal. 9 Li. BARCELONA"; large checkered wood grips w/3-bar crest impressed in each; slidestop retainer is like Tokarev! huge/extended bushing & 1" barrel extension beyond slide; incorrect mag; smooth, fading 90% finish and rare!! \$750
82. IVER JOHNSON M1900 "TARGET MODEL", .22 cal., 16XXX range; 6" octagonal bbl; & 1-piece wood grip are both perfect as is overall revolver! \$150
83. KIMBALL .30 cal. Carbine PISTOL, 10X range; one of the actual production examples (1st 130 or so) & not assembled from parts! 100% perfect & with original factory box (box has been repaired); rare!! \$1250
84. KOMMER, 6.35mm, 8XX range; (see Mathews, Vol.II, p.53 top photo) the Model III as shown in reference, but with short grip/mag; oval grip logo & Crown/N proofs; 97% blue & overall a beauty; very scarce! \$225
85. KOMMER, 7.65mm, 14XXX range; EAGLE/N nazi era proofed at Zella-Mehlis! very close to M1910 Browning design with 96-98% thin bluing, exc. grips fading straps (Mathews, Vol.II, p.384); exc. & scarce type! \$300
86. LAHTI, HUSQVARNA, 9mm, 67XXX range; Crown/SS proofs at rear & "Rplt.SXXXX" markings; perfect bore, grips, & 97-98% fine blue; exc++! \$325
87. LAHTI, VKT 1-35, 9mm; from Finland & much scarcer with 98% blue; exc+ \$750
88. LANGENHAN, 7.65mm, 25XXX range; GERMAN WWI IMPERIAL PROOFED example; fine original grips show normal signs of deterioration (bone like mat'l); few dings & hints of frost, otherwise 98% fine blue; exc! \$200
89. LUGER, DWM M1900 AM.EAGLE, 7.65mm Para., 91XX range; 'GERMANY' marked; has correct woodbase mag; 'reblued' with buffing apparent & some pits visible under blue; mechanically fine; shootin or for parts \$425
90. LUGER, DWM "1912", 9mm, 5XXX range; no lug or holdopen ever present; match except woodbase mag. which is exc; bright exc. bore & beautiful straw parts (perhaps restrawed, but if so very professional!); the lovely grips are exc. too! about 98% fine blue, somewhat dull on straps & a very few slight hints of frost; overall exc+! \$750
91. LUGER, DWM "1916", 9mm, 36XXo range; std. WWI issue with original matching mag. having minute chip; lovely straw & exc. bore; almost 98% of the original blue remains; an exc+ example of honest WWI Luger! \$600
92. LUGER, DWM "1917", 9mm, 23XXe range; again, with matching magazine; minute chip in left grip by safety, otherwise grips again exc; bore dark; nice straw colors and about 97% original blued finish; exc! \$500
93. LUGER, DWM REWORK, 9mm, 6XXb range; "PTV" Police rework (see Costanzo, p243 #47, p85 1920 Simson, p351 Eagle/RC, p80 #26); rare proofing per the reference; stainless Haenel Schmeisser mag. is matching with Eagle/L proof & virtually perfect! bright bore w/hint of darkness; sear safety; about half straw & smooth, even 95% original blue remains; exc. condition & very desirable variation! \$900
94. LUGER, SIMSON, 9mm, 12XX range; Simson mag. sn. is 624; gripstrap markings "13./J.R.38.13"; fine grips show normal usage/wear; smooth, 80% of original blue remains; small chips face of bolt; nice Simson! \$725
95. LUGER, SIMSON, 9mm, 1XXa range; sear safe & no chamber date, plus early H. Schmeisser mag. (mismatch); lovely 95% straw & nearly 98% original blue except for fading straps; bright, exc. bore; minute chip of left grip by safety; otherwise exc. grips; w/1931 Police holster in 'aged' condition w/tool present; exc. or better & scarce! \$1150
96. LUGER, "byf 41", 9mm, 8XXXa range; correct & matching thruout w/exc. grips bore, & finish; retains nearly 98-99% blue except for high edge wear; an honest & very crisp WWII Luger! exc++++! \$700
97. LUGER, "MAUSER 1939" (BANNER), 9mm, 23XXw range; COMPLETE RIG WITH TWO (2) MATCHING MAGS. & POLICE HOLSTER! Eagle/C proofed exceptional outfit with 97-98% original blue with fading only; almost exc++!! \$1650

98. LUGER, "MAUSER 42" (BANNER), 7.65mmPara; no other markings whatsoever & believed to be sample for Swedish market; perfect bore, exc. grips & mag; straw fading slightly, but smooth; retains about 98% blued finish except faded straps; fascinating variation & rare! \$1750
99. LUGER, 9mm, EAGLE/N DWM REWORK, 2XXXa range; DWM toggle, no chamber date; fine straw colors & 97% blue; EAGLE/N PROOFS ABOUND! large "A" on barrel with "Fahrman" (similar to VONO/ANSCHUTZ rework); about exc+ overall & another very scarce, honest, variation! \$750
100. LUGER IDEAL GRIPS; very good, showing handling & age; scarce accy.! \$225
101. MAKAROV, 9mmM; ca.1968 w/perfect bore & grip of reddish plastic w/star design; 95% quality, lustre blue save one smooth rub; exc! \$1200
102. MAKAROV, 9mmM; exc. bore & grip again, & retains about 97% finish; however finish generally 'frosted' overall; most recent date I've seen in this type and unusual thereby; overall about very good or more!\$900
- A103. MAMBA, 9mm, 78PV01XXX range; African made stainless, double-action variation of which only about 100 ever made! w/box & brochure! \$500
- A104. MAUSER "CONEHAMMER" M1896 "BROOMHANDLE", 7.63mm, 5XXX range; 'antique' as made prior to 1899! rear sight marked "MAUSER CARTRIDGE 303" with 100, 200, & 300 yard graduations; dark bore; nearly 95% of original blue except faded straps & barrel; original matching shoulder-stock w/normal handling & wear (some nail holes where strap was attached); very scarce, early outfit (from a collection) exc!\$2000
103. MAUSER "LARGE RING" M1896, 7.63mm, 22XXX range; "FLATSIDE" VARIATION (see SYSTEM MAUSER, p.72);"1-10"sight graduations; nice, original grips & smooth finish with perhaps half the blue faded; weak bore; mechanically sound & overall a vg+ example of early 'Broomhandle'!\$950
104. MAUSER "LARGE RING" M1896, 7.63mm, 34XXX range; 'Deep Milled Panel' (see p.90, System Mauser); shows considerable usage but has the very RARE "CHERUB" BLACK PLASTIC GRIPS,(some small chips & wear) \$900
105. MAUSER "LARGE RING" M1896, 7.63mm, 34XXX range; about 97% fine, original blue with matching stock (wood shows handling & 2 slight cracks); especially attractive set from the same collection; about exc+\$1650
106. MAUSER M1896, 7.63mm, 87XXX range; another matching stocked example; the black plastic (original) grips show wear/use; about 90% smooth, original blue finish; overall another exc. combination! \$1250
107. MAUSER M1896, 7.63mm, 91XXX range; "MAUSER" (BANNER) chamber marking (p.116 System Mauser); hard rubber (or black plastic-) grips show wear again; fine bright bore, & British proofs; nicely reblued with about 99% finish remaining; an exc. and scarce BANNER example! \$850
108. MAUSER M1896, 9mm ('BIG RED 9'!), 69XXX range; complete with matching stock & correct/authentic (nothing repro here!) leather harness & cleaning rod; perfect bore, grips, & retains 98% original blue; moreover, bears numerous nazi period acceptance proofs (similar to M712 Mauser Schnellfeuer examples observed); 100% authentic and extremely rare; a true prize for the 'Broomhandle' collector & exc+! \$3500
109. MAUSER 6-SHOT BOLO M1896, 7.63mm, 40XXX range; with matching, original "SHORTNECKED" BOLO STOCK! this represents another true rarity for 'Broomhandle' collectors; floral pattern black plastic grips are fine; lanyard loop at butt; dark bore; professionally restored & retains almost 100% lovely, lustre blue & fire blue colors; truly magnificent outfit (slight crack in stock) & extraordinary! \$5750
110. MAUSER M1934, 7.65mm, 525XXX range; Swedish Police contract w/black plastic grips & lanyard loop; complete w/factory box & brush; almost 99% lustre blue with minor rub mark on strap; exc+ to near mint! \$400

MAUSER HSc, 7.65mm, 779XXX range; NAVY CONTRACT PROOF on left web of the trigger guard; about 97-98% finish, with slight hints of frost & dulling straps; fine grips & perf. bore; "dla42" coded holster is not Navy marked but special pattern & believed authentic; spare mag.included; exceptional 'rig' in exc. or better condition! \$500
