



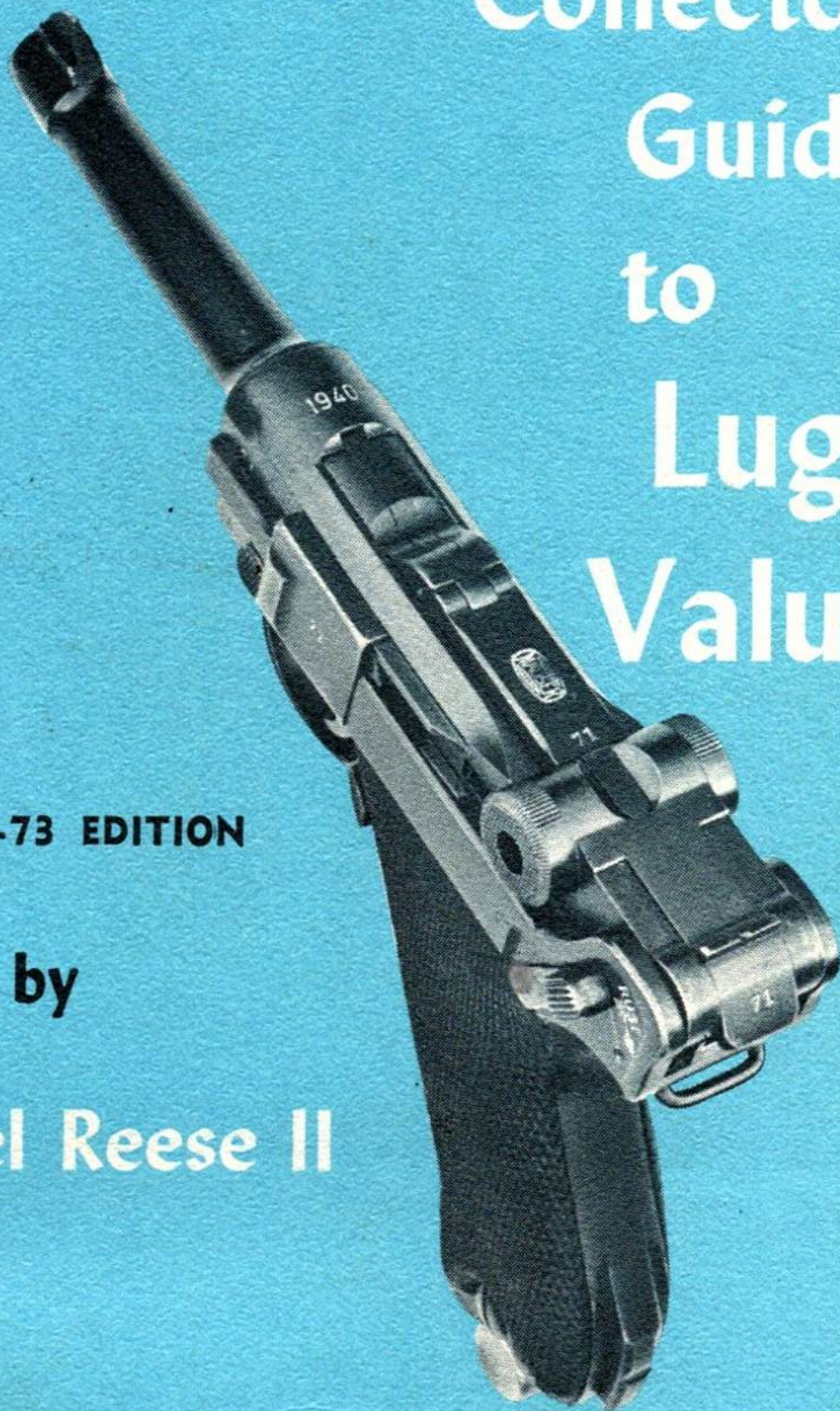

INTRODUCTION

It should be pointed out that prices indicated in this value guide are *collector's values; i.e.*, these are the top current prices for which the listed Lugers can be expected to be sold.

Locality is of no consideration in determining price. Values indicated herein range from NRA *GOOD* to NRA *MINT*. The only area for negotiation of prices is the range of difference in condition of the Luger between these two categories.

The value of a Luger is absolute. No more should be paid for it; no less should be received for it. If, for example, a Luger is worth \$300, that is its value for every purpose: buying, selling or trading. This is true collecting. Anything else is business.

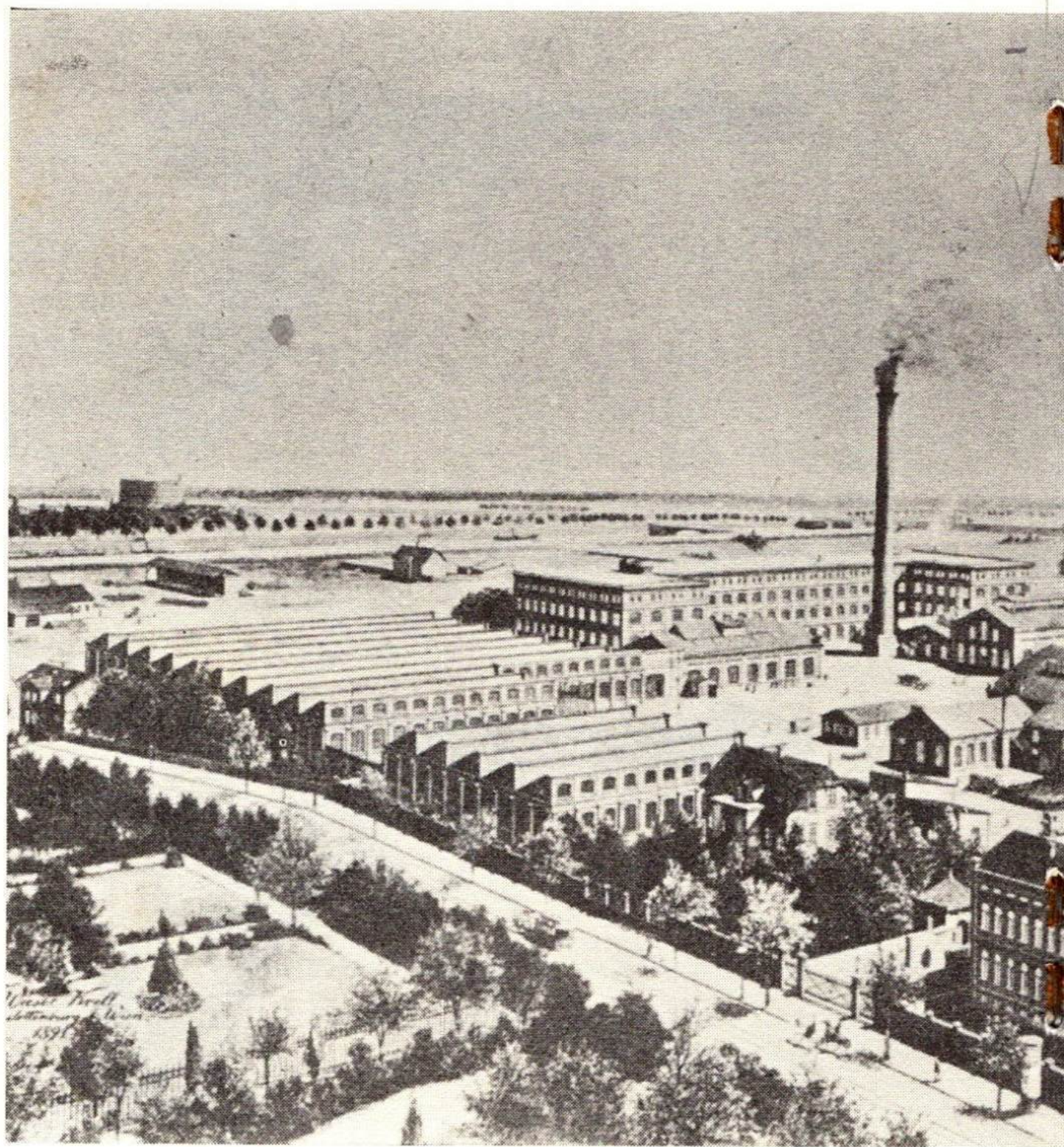

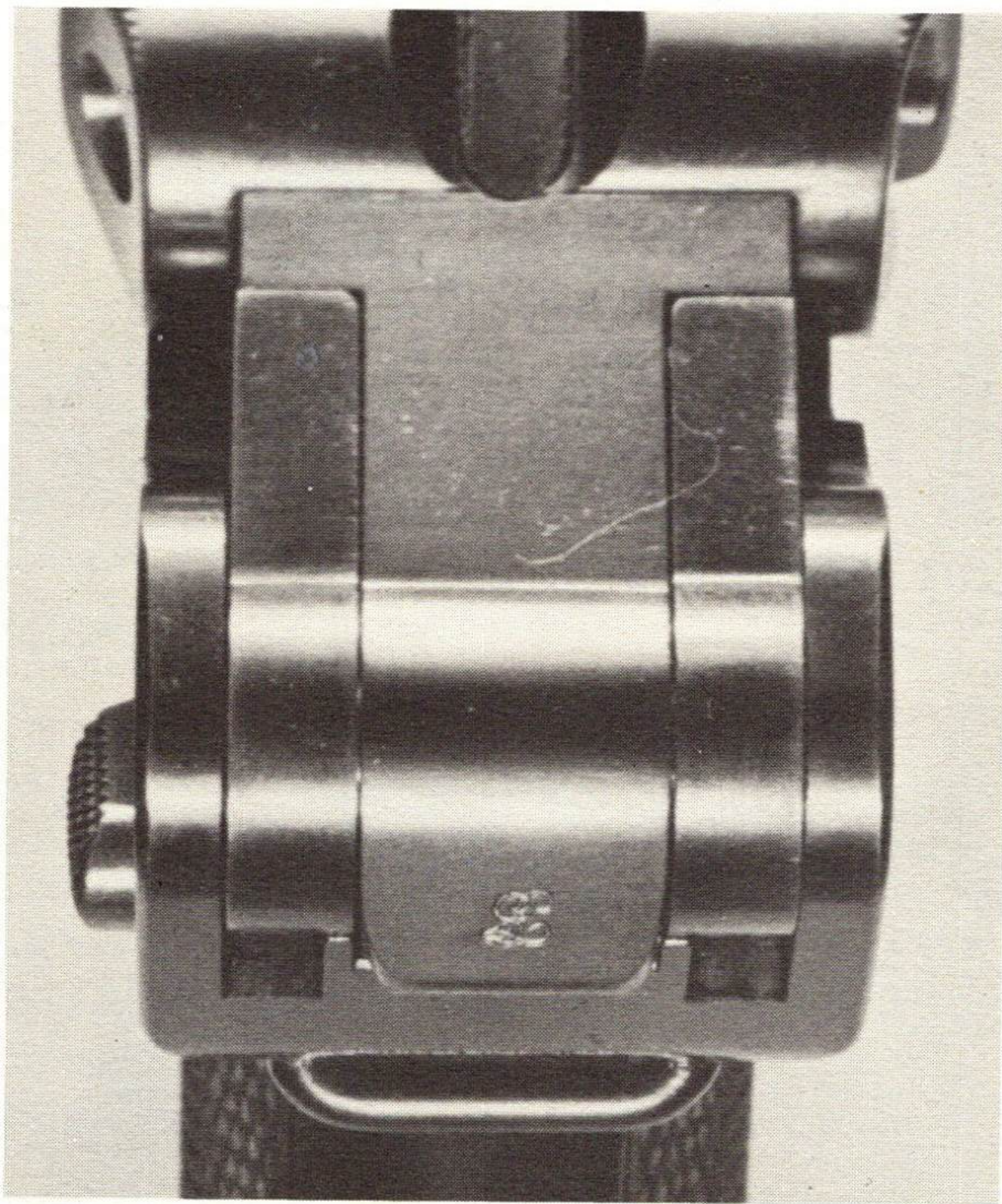

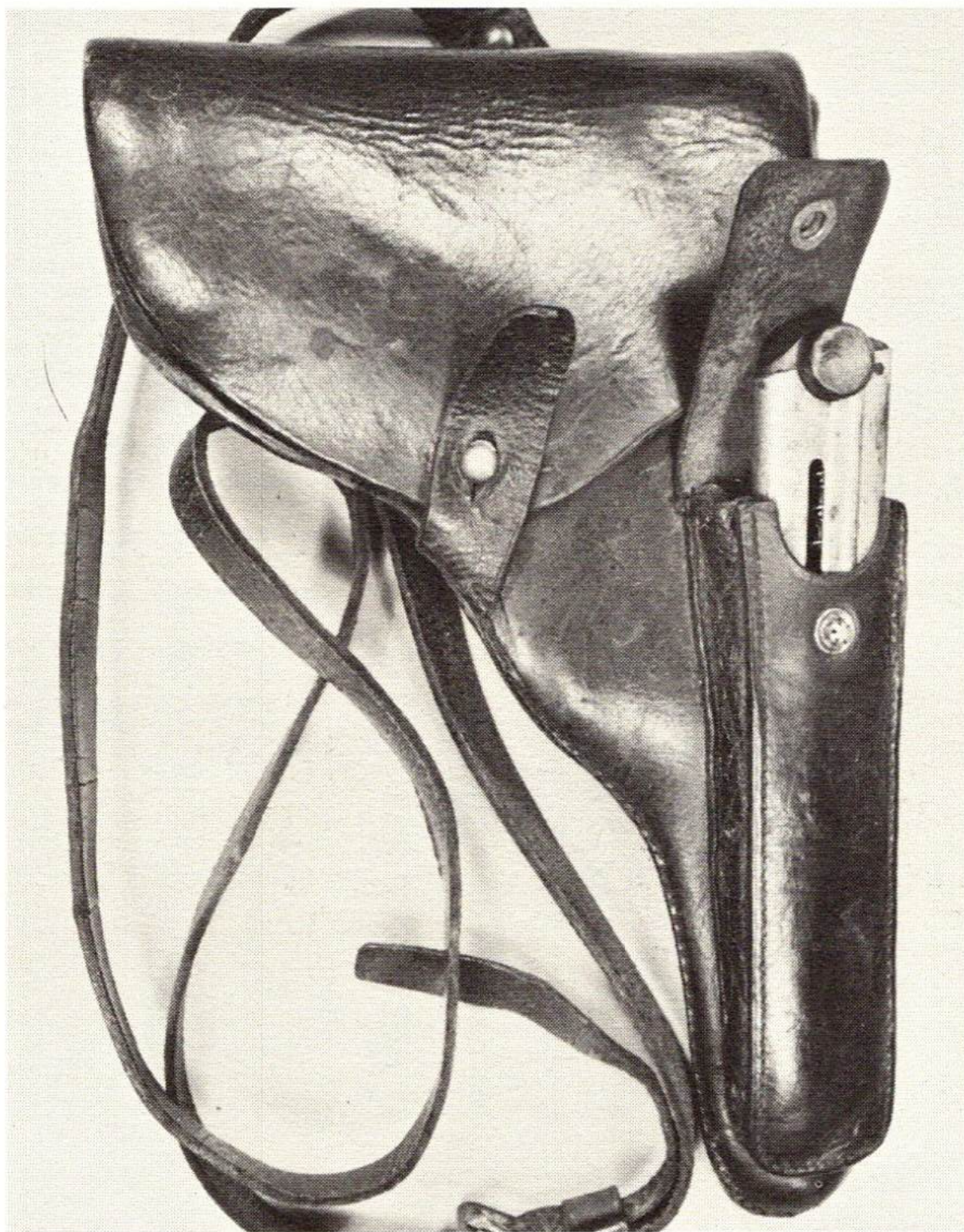

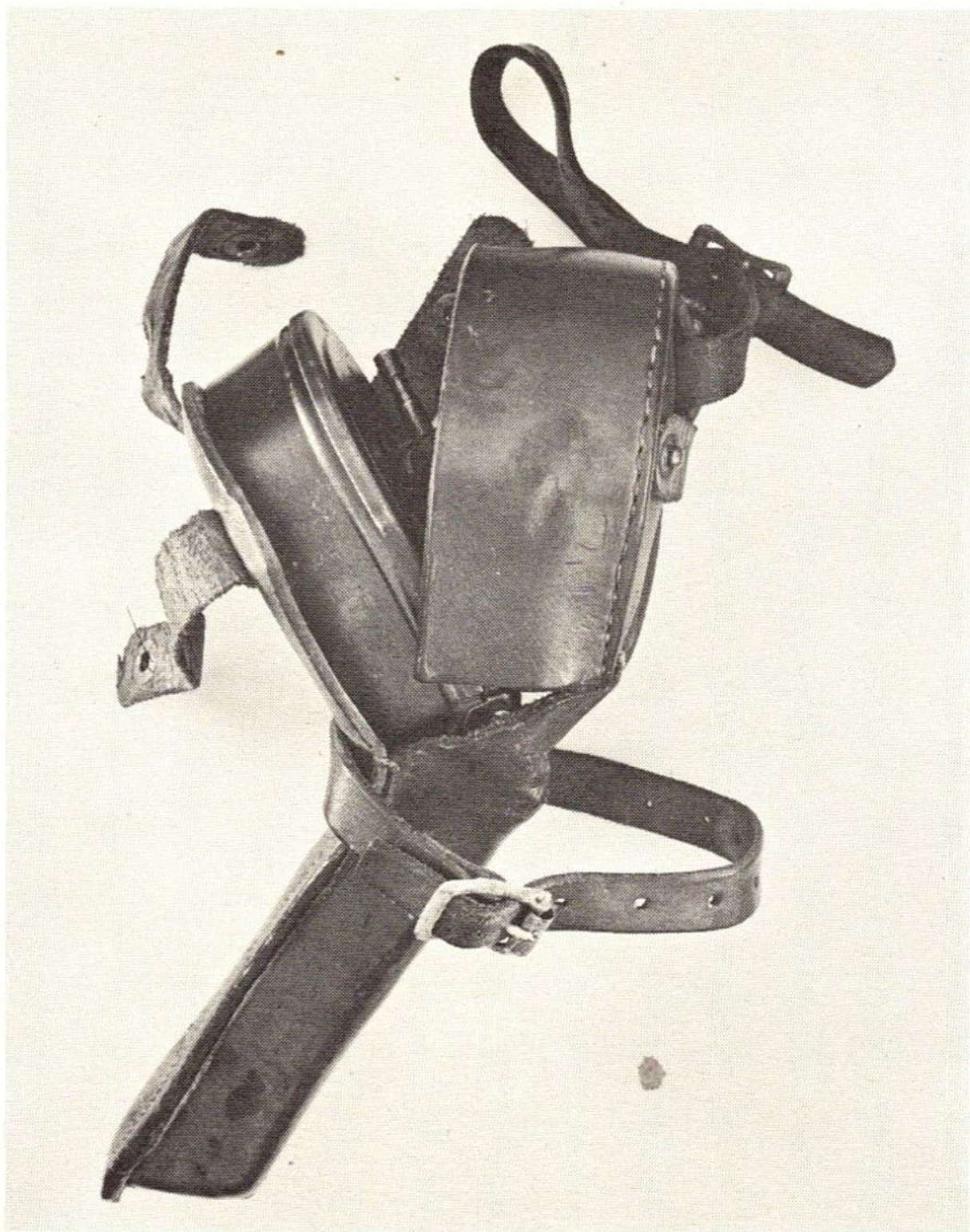
