

In a letter written by brother John "Cubby" Gulbranson (AΓ838), the family asked with pride and humility to consider their son Patrick for honorary initiation to Lambda Chi Alpha. At 34 years old, Patrick has lived a full and active life.

"Down Syndrome has never bothered Patrick and should not bother you," wrote John. "He is a remarkable young man and will make you proud to welcome him as a brother."

Patrick Gulbranson is a 2008 graduate of Waukee High School, Waukee, Iowa, where he was very active in high school activities. Patrick has been an employee of McDonald's Restaurant in Stuart, Iowa, since before he was out of high school. He is an Eagle Scout and is a Vigil Honor member of the Order of the Arrow. He enjoyed a 10 -day backpacking trip to Philmont Scout Ranch, Cimarron, New Mexico.

In June of this year, Patrick was a member of the Special Olympics Iowa team to the Special Olympics USA Games in Orlando. He competed in bowling and finished 4th in individual, 5th in doubles and 7th in team bowling.

Patrick is one of two athlete members of the Special Olympics Iowa Board of Directors. He is also a Special Olympics Global Messenger, which is a select group of athletes that meets with and speaks to groups and businesses promoting respect and inclusion for persons with disabilities.

"The fraternity has always been about sincerity, diversity and inclusion," John wrote. "Patrick would be more than just a token example of that. He can actually contribute to validating the fraternity's values."
