Long list of Lambda Chi Doctors in Sturgis

Sturgis, South Dakota, has a lengthy lineage of Lambda Chi's in the medical profession, and for some reason, their names begin with "L".

In the Spring of 1970, a small pledge class (i.e. Associate Members!) including Curt Liedtke, Chuck Lewis and Ross Lamphere joined Lambda Chi Alpha at USD, with Ross having graduated from Sturgis High School. Dave Landry, also from Sturgis, had just joined the previous semester, and even though Ross knew that, he and the others joined Lambda Chi anyway.

Liedtke had graduated from Brandon Valley High School, and was soon followed by fellow Brandon Valley alumnus David Lauer. Liedtke, Lewis and Lauer all became doctors and located to Sturgis, while Dave Landry eventually received a nursing degree (although to my knowledge, Landry never assisted Liedtke, Lewis or Lauer).

But these brothers weren't the first doctors to be associated from Sturgis. Dr. Bruce Lushbough, MD, AG 509, graduated from Sturgis High School in 1951, and as Aberdeen alumnus Dr. Tom Aman remembers, brother Lushbough was part of the South Dakota Boys' Basketball State Championship team that year. (That team was coached by Buell Woodle, the Hall-of-Fame Sturgis coach, and included future Colorado All-American Carroll Hardy.)

Fast forward to 1983, and Lambda Chi Brett Lynass moved to Sturgis to start his Physical Therapy practice, after graduating from USD's PT program with Honors.

Sturgis natives Mike Goodhope, AG 1531, and Chris Haas, AG 1665, have also become doctors, but their names didn't start with "L"...

So Lambda Chi's Lushbough, Landry, Liedtke, Lewis, Lauer and Lynass have all had a tie to Sturgis and the medical field. Only Lamphere failed to go into medicine (although he did serve on Monument Health Network's Board of Directors and helped start the Rural Sturgis Ambulance Group, so I guess that counts for something...).;) (Author's note—Ross is my father.)



Hello, brothers! I am Tayte Gleason, the presiding High Alpha at our own Alpha-Gamma chapter. After over an entire year since the start of COVID, the chapter is finally beginning its gradual transition back to normalcy. Living in-house under the constant threat of quarantine definitely was a difficult change of pace, but we are nearing the light at the end of the tunnel. With stable virus numbers across campus so far this semester, many of our social opportunities are beginning to open once again.
