RESOLUTION No. 2026-05

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF WILDER RURAL FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT;

- **Providing for Recitals;**
- **Preparing, Approving, and Adopting the First Amended and Reformed Budget Fiscal Year 2025-2026 to include as additional Revenue Description, development impact fees from the City of Wilder and the Canyon County Capital Projects Trust Funds (Impact Fees); and to include, as additional Anticipated Expenditures, the expenditure of the Impact Fees for equipping Water Tender 82 (2017 International Tactical Tender). This notice contains a statement of the estimated revenue from property taxes and the total amount from sources other than property taxes and contains the proposed expenditures and revenues for the FY2025-2026;**
- **Directing the District Secretary.**

Section 1: Recitals

- 1.1 WHEREAS**, the Commissioners of the Wilder Rural Fire Protection District caused to be prepared a proposed amended and reformed budget for the fiscal year commencing on the 1st day of October 2025 and ending on the 30th day of September 2026 and caused the same together with a notice of public hearing to be timely published and posted as required by Idaho Code § 31-1422; and
- 1.2 WHEREAS**, a public hearing will be held on the proposed budget hearing on the 13th day of August 2026, as advertised and noticed in the Idaho Press Tribune; and
- 1.3 WHEREAS**, the Commissioners have determined that it is in the best interests of the residents and property lying within the Fire District and necessary to provide the level of service required for the preservation of life and property within the Fire District that the following amended budget be adopted; and
- 1.4 WHEREAS**, the Commissioners are authorized and directed by the provisions of Idaho Code § 31-1423(1) immediately prior to the annual levy of taxes by Canyon County, to levy a tax upon all the taxable property within the boundaries of the Wilder Rural Fire Protection District sufficient to defray the costs of equipping and maintaining the Fire District to be used for the purposes as set forth in Chapter 14 of Title 31 Idaho Code and for no other purpose; and,
- 1.5 WHEREAS**, the Commissioners are required and directed by the provisions of Idaho Code § 31-1423 (1) to establish the levy entered upon the minutes of the Board of Commissioners, and it shall then be the duty of the secretary of this Fire District to transmit to the Canyon County Auditor and the Canyon County Assessor certified copies of this resolution providing for such levy.

NOW, THEREFORE, based upon the above declarations, **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Commissioners of the Wilder Rural Fire Protection District, Canyon County, Idaho as follows:

Section 2: Adoption of Amended Budget

2.1 That in compliance with the requirements of Idaho Code § 31-1422, the Wilder Rural Fire Protection District does hereby adopt as its First Amended and Reformed budget for the fiscal year commencing on the 1st day of October 2025 and ending on the 30th day of September 2026 and as herein shown, there is appropriated out of the money in the treasury of the Wilder Rural Fire Protection District for the purpose of deferring the necessary expenses and liabilities of said Fire District for the fiscal year beginning on the 1st day of October 2025 the sums of money, or so much thereof as may be necessary for the following amounts, to-wit:

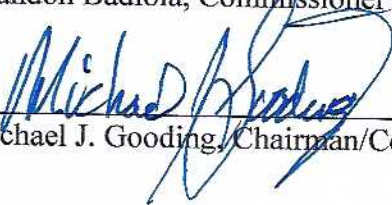
