Exhibitors Please Note:

Exhibitor must indicate if they wish to sell a qualifying animal by placing a "Y" or "N" online at time of entry. Once you have made your declaration, you will not be allowed to change this declaration. If more than 1 are eligible for the sale that were marked "Y", auction committee and auction clerk will make the final decision as to which ones will sell.

RABBIT EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE:

1. **This show is NOT an ARBA Sanctioned Show.** Rabbits will, however, be judged following the rules and guidelines under ARBA.
2. Exhibitor must own and be raising rabbit on or before February 1, 2023. No exceptions.
3. A copy of Pedigree papers must be provided on entry deadline day.
4. Entries must have a legible, clearly defined tattoo ~ in the left ear. This must be done prior to receiving day. No tattooing will be done on the fairgrounds.
5. Indicate breed and age of rabbit ~ ex: Division=Breed, Class=Age/Sex, Breed Variety=Breed. If you are uncertain about the age of your animal, contact your leader, advisor or the Department Superintendent.
6. Rabbits with evidence of parasites or contagious disease will be disqualified and returned to owner for removal from building or quarantined. Unruly, mean and biting animals will not be accepted.
7. Breeding animals at the fairgrounds is prohibited. A doe that has babies at the fair will forfeit wins.
8. **Waterers & feeders must be furnished by the exhibitor. Exhibitors are responsible for feeding their animals throughout the fair. Mornings feedings must be done by 10 am and evening feedings must be done by 8:00 pm.**
9. Pinal County Fair is not responsible for any loss or damage to animals, equipment, etc. that might occur. Entries are made and accepted on this condition.

10. The fair is not responsible for animals left after specified release times.
11. Rabbits cannot be removed from cages without permission from the Department Coordinator. Notify Superintendent for showmanship. Double divided cages will be used.
12. Exhibitors do not place anything in rabbit cages without permission from the Coordinator. Violation can result in disqualification.
13. ***Do Not attach "for sale" cards to cages. If you are found to be attempting to sell an animal outside of the auction, you will be disqualified, forfeit all prizes and auction monies.***
14. Exhibits for fryer, baker, and roaster will be entered in regular division.
15. Pinal County Fair Dress Code required.
16. Removal of show animals prior to the end of fair is prohibited. **(only exceptions that will be made are for health reasons by fair officials)**

DIVISION 3750: Meat Pen

It takes approximately 8 weeks to raise a Meat Pen. Entries cannot be more than ten weeks old. All three rabbits should look as much alike as possible. General disqualifications apply in this class. Rabbits must have a permanent tattoo mark. Tattoo must be recorded on the entry form.

Class Description

242 Breeds maturing - three live rabbits per pen - any sex - uniform in size. Top weight for each rabbit is 5 lbs.

DIVISION 3751: Fryer

Class Description

244 Maximum age 10 weeks ~ maximum weight 5 lbs.

DIVISION 3752: Baker

Class Description

245 Less than 6 mo. old: Minimum weight 5.5 lbs.~ maximum weight 8 lbs.

DIVISION 3753: Roaster

Class Description

246 More than 6 mo. Old: Minimum weight 8 lbs.

DIVISION 3754: Rabbit Poster Contest - No entry fee. Must be entered as exhibitor in this department. Poster relating to and about Rabbit. Two entries per exhibitor. Poster must be submitted day of rabbit receiving. All posters will be displayed. Poster size 18"x 24".

Class Description

01 Junior: 8yr to 13yr prior to Jan. 1, 2023

02 Senior: 14yr to 18yr prior to Jan 1, 2023

DIVISION 3755: Showmanship - SHOWMANSHIP IS MANDATORY TO BE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN AUCTION.

Must be entered at time of Entry.

100 Junior Novice: Junior members in first year projects

101 Junior: Age 8yr - 13yr prior to Jan. 1, 2023

102 Senior Novice: Senior members in first year projects

103 Senior: Ages 14yr-18yr prior to Jan. 1, 2023

Winners of novice division have the option to show in non-novice division. Winners from class 101, 103 will represent the Department in the ***Round Robin Showmanship.***
