**AWARDS:** Each project will be judged using the American System.

1. Best of Show will receive a rosette and a belt buckle.
2. **Division 4105 Only-** Best FFA Chapter/4-H Club: Awarded to the chapters/clubs participating in Chapter/Club sweepstakes.

#### AGRICULTURAL MECHANICS EXHIBITORS:

1. ALL Youth Pinal County Residents are eligible for entry. See General Rules for age requirements.
2. Exhibitors aged 8-10 years old prior to January 1, 2025 (Pre-Juniors) may enter **Division 4000** and **4106** only.
3. Exhibitors must make projects during the current fair year. A number of common skills must have been applied to construct a useful labor-saving item appropriate for the farm, home, or to the student or group of students instrumental in its construction.
4. Exhibitors shall include a minimum of a 1-paragraph summary about their project's construction process. This should include but is not limited to materials used, hours spent on construction, lessons learned, photos, and other interesting facts for public information. This information will be displayed with the project at the Fair.
5. **Please Note: Do Not Enter as a School, all entries must list Exhibitor Names and contact information. An exception to this would be the Chapter/4-H Club Sweepstakes (Division 4105).**
6. **Exhibitors must sell their projects at the Silent Auction, while on display during the Pinal County Fair. You must include the starting bid on the entry, if no starting bid is listed, it defaults to \$1.** Any questions concerning the Silent Auction contact the Department Coordinator.
7. Exhibitors cannot enter more than 2 exhibits per division. No more than 10 exhibits per exhibitor.
8. All exhibits entered in this department must be for sale.
9. **The Silent Auction will open on Wednesday, March 12, 2025, and close on Saturday, March 15, 2025, at 3:00 pm.** At that time, the bid sheets will be collected, and full payment must be made before items will be allowed to leave the fairgrounds. There will be a 6% commission deducted from the purchase price of each project. Exhibitor checks will be mailed for disbursement after the fair, not prior to June 1.
10. Teachers/Volunteers from each chapter/club are needed for the closing of the auction to assist the coordinator in organizing sales from 3 pm to 6:30 pm.

***\*Sold auctioned items (that can be hand-carried out) will be released on Saturday, March 15, 2025, no earlier than 5 pm after receiving payment.***
