#### Youth Miniature Dairy Goat Department Rules

Complete entries include online entry plus Exhibitor Signature form with all signatures, copy of YQCA certificate and Seasonal Pass and entry fees. Entries MUST be entered online and supporting documents must be uploaded (see red box). No mailed entries are accepted. *Incomplete entries will not be accepted.*

#### **DAIRY GOAT EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE:**

- 1. This show is open to miniature goats not eligible to be registered by ADGA. All does must be registered in the youth exhibitor's name (or family name) with either MDGA, or TMGR. Animals not meeting this criterion WILL NOT be allowed to show. Does under six months of age can be shown with an official stamped duplicate registration. Animals (kids under 6 months) waiting for registration paperwork must be able to submit proof of both parents' registration.
- 2. All animals must be kept in a livestock area. Any exhibitor found with their animal outside livestock area will not be allowed to participate in the auction. Species coordinator may make exceptions to this rule as needed.
- 3. Age base is March 1, 2026. Use the base date to establish the age of the animal for proper class placement for the show.
- 4. The exhibitor must have an animal entered in the miniature dairy goat department to participate in showmanship. Miniature Dairy Goat exhibitors will compete in the same showmanship class as Youth Dairy Goat exhibitors.
- 5. Scurs, over 2" on does, not accepted.
- 6. Bucks over 3 months of age and horned animals are not eligible.
- 7. Animals are to come clipped/trimmed.
- 8. Exhibitors are responsible for tattoos on animals entering the show ring.
- 9. Pens will be assigned by the coordinator based on the number of animals entered. No pen switching will be allowed. Tack pens will be assigned only if space is available. No pen consideration will be made for animals not entered in the show.
- 10. Pinal County Fair Dress Code required. Refer to General Rules NOTE: in addition, dairy showman may wear show whites.

- 11. Dairy goats will be sold in the small auction and not the large livestock auction. <u>Animals must be entered and judged in Division 3308: Dairy goats for Auction, to be eligible to sell.</u>
- 12. All kids must be checked in with the coordinator by the check-in deadline.
- 13. Animals that are due to kid within 2 weeks of the fair are ineligible to attend the fair.
- \*\* Nursing kids born after the deadline and before March 13, 2026 are eligible to come to fair but will not be allowed to enter to show.\*\*

## <u>DIVISION 3215: Showmanship – Combined with Youth Dairy Goat Showmanship</u>

Must be entered at time of Entry. All exhibitors are required to enroll in showmanship classes.

Class	Description
100	Junior Novice: Junior member - first year project
101	Junior: 8yrs -13yrs prior to Jan. 1, 2026
102	Senior Novice: Senior member - first year project

103 Senior: 14yrs -18yrs prior to Jan. 1, 2026

Winners of the novice division have the option to show in a non-novice division. Winners from class 101, 103 will represent the Dairy Goat Department in the *Round Robin Showmanship Contest*.

### Division 3317 Pet Dairy Goat Showmanship -Shared Family Entry

This division is intended for youth exhibitors who wish to participate with a family pet dairy goat that may be shared among siblings. Pet dairy goats may be shown by any youth exhibitor within the family, but only one exhibitor may handle and show the animal in the ring. Animals in this division must already be registered in a breed division by the owning exhibitor. The exhibitor in the pet class cannot be entered in any other classes within this species. Exhibitors in the Pet Division are not eligible for Round Robin Showmanship. Only the designated owner of the animal, as listed on the entry form, is eligible to enter the animal in the auction (if applicable). Animals in this division should be clean, healthy, and handled regularly. Winners in this division will receive ribbon prizes.

103	Senior: Ages 14yr-18yr prior to Jan. 1, 2026

### **DIVISION 3308: Miniature Dairy Goats for Auction**

Animals must be entered in this division if they wish to participate in the small stock Auction.

- 1. If the exhibitor has 2 animals entered, they *MUST* inform the coordinator within one hour following the end of the show, to declare which animal will sell.
- 2. Exhibitors can enter 2 but are limited to selling a total of one Dairy Goat in the Auction.
