## Exhibitors Please Note:

Exhibitor must indicate if they wish to sell a qualifying animal by placing a "Y" or "N" online at time of entry. Once you have made your declaration, you will not be allowed to change this declaration. If more than 1 are eligible for the sale that were marked "Y", auction committee and auction clerk will make the final decision as to which ones will sell.

# CAVY EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE:

- 1. Not ARBA or ACBA sanctioned show judged using ACBA Guidelines.
- 2. Diseased or unsightly cavies will not be admitted and must be removed from the fairgrounds.
- 3. All animals must be ear tagged prior to arrival on receiving day.
- 4. No breeding of animals will be allowed on the fairgrounds at any time.
- 5. Waterers & feeders must be furnished by the exhibitor. Exhibitors are responsible for feeding their animals throughout the fair. Morning feedings must be done by 9 am and evening feedings must be done by 8:30 pm.
- 6. Pinal County Dress Code required.
- 7. Removal of show animals, prior to the end of fair is prohibited. (Exceptions will only be made by fair officials for health reasons).
- 8. Pinal County Fair is not responsible for any loss or damage to animals, equipment, etc. that might occur. Entries are made and accepted on this condition.
- 9. The fair is not responsible for animals left after specified release times.
- 10. Do Not attach "for sale" cards to cages. If you are found to be attempting to sell an animal outside of the auction, you will be disqualified, forfeit all prizes and auction monies.
- 11. Pinal County Fair Dress Code required.
- 12. Animals may not be removed from barn unless approved by Species Coordinator.
