Exhibitors Please Note:

Exhibitors must indicate if they wish to sell a qualifying animal by placing a "Y" or "N" online at the time of entry. If more than 1 is eligible for the sale that was marked "Y", and a declaration for sale was not made within 60 minutes after the show, the auction committee and auction clerk will make the final decision as to which one will sell.

CAVY EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE:

- 1. Not an ARBA or ACBA-sanctioned show Cavies will be judged using ACBA Guidelines.
- 2. Exhibitors must own and be raising the animal on or before **January 1, 2026**. No exceptions.
- 3. Diseased or unsightly Cavies will not be admitted and must be removed from the fairgrounds.
- 4. All animals must be ear-tagged prior to arrival on receiving day.
- 5. No breeding of animals will be allowed on the fairgrounds at any time.
- 6. Waterers & feeders must be furnished by the exhibitor. Exhibitors are responsible for feeding their animals throughout the fair. Morning feedings must be done by 9 am and evening feedings must be done by 7:00 pm.
- 7. Pinal County Dress Code required.
- 8. Removal of show animals, prior to the end of the Fair is prohibited. (Exceptions will only be made by fair officials for health reasons).
- 9. Pinal County Fair is not responsible for any loss or damage to animals, equipment, etc. that might occur. Entries are made and accepted on this condition.
- 10. The fair is not responsible for animals left after specified release times.
- 11. Do Not attach "for sale" cards to cages. If you are found to be attempting to sell an animal outside of the auction, you will be disqualified, and forfeit all prizes and auction monies.
- 12. Animals may not be removed from the barn unless approved by the Species Coordinator.

DIVISION 3825: Showmanship - *SHOWMANSHIP IS REQUIRED FOR ALL EXHIBITORS. Must be entered at the time of Entry.

Division 3815 Pet Cavy Showmanship -Shared Family Entry

This division is intended for youth exhibitors who wish to participate with a family pet cavy that may be shared among siblings. Pet cavies may be shown by any youth exhibitor within the family, but only one exhibitor may handle and show the animal in the ring. Animals in this division must already be registered in a breed division by the owning exhibitor. The exhibitor in the pet class can not be entered in any other classes within this species. Exhibitors in the Pet Division are not eligible for Round Robin Showmanship. Only the designated owner of the animal, as listed on the entry form, is eligible to enter the animal in the Junior Livestock Auction (if applicable). Animals in this division should be clean, healthy, and handled regularly. Winners in this division will receive ribbon prizes.
