The Azusa Amateur Radio Communication Emergency Service (A.A.C.E.S.) is a volunteer group of amateur radio operators who are licensed to operate HAM radios. A.A.C.E.S. has been a volunteer organization at the Azusa Police Department for over two decades. This group has dedicated itself to serve the City of Azusa by volunteering for a variety of community events and by working in the City of Azusa Emergency Operations Center (EOC).

A.A.C.E.S. assists every year with communications along the Golden Days Parade route, they assisted with the Canyon City Marathon, the LA County Homeless Count, and they've helped with countless other community events. A.A.C.E.S. members also volunteer their time to perform mission critical duties for the City of Azusa EOC. Most recently, A.A.C.E.S. conducted a training for the City Safety Committee to teach them how to properly set up the EOC.

One of their most important EOC functions is to set up the EOC so City staff has proper workspace and resources to handle large scale emergencies such as wild fires, floods, and earthquakes. In the event of a major disaster or incident where our emergency communications fail, the A.A.C.E.S. group has the ability to activate our HAM radio systems and immediately communicate with our local, State, and Federal public safety partners. They perform a monthly Area D mutual aid radio test to ensure communication readiness with our law enforcement partners.

The Azusa Police Department and the City of Azusa are fortunate to have dedicated volunteer group such A.A.C.E.S. We thank them for their service and present them with the certificate of appreciation.
