## Watering Restrictions

Watering is allowed before 8 AM or after 6 PM. Learn more at <u>HCFLGov.net/WaterRestrictions</u> Hillsborough County cu**r**rently allows two watering days per week based on your house number: Addresses ending in:

- **0**, **1**, **2**, **3**: Monday & Thursday
- **4**, **5**, **6**: Tuesday & Friday
- 7, 8, 9: Wednesday & Saturday
