Re: Zoning Adjustment Application - ZA-374-25 - 12019 North 19th Avenue

Dear Property Owner or Neighborhood Association Representative:

This firm represents Eros Investments, LLC, (the "Owner") and Martin Chacon (the "Applicant") regarding their proposal to have limited outdoor display of new tires on the C-2 zoned parcel at 12019 North 19th Avenue, Phoenix, which is also known as APN 159-04-002H (the "Property"). The Property is highlighted on the enclosed aerial parcel maps. We recently filed a zoning adjustment application with Phoenix for the project as the Phoenix Zoning Ordinance requires a use permit for the outdoor display to occur. The purpose of this letter is to notify you of an upcoming public hearing on the application.

The Owner purchased the Property in late 2024 for a tire and wheel business. Given outdoor display on other properties along 19th Avenue and Cactus Road, the Applicant thought similar display and storage of tires on the Property was permissible. However, the C-2 district has strict limitations on outdoor display and requires use permit approval for the display. The Phoenix Neighborhood Services Department issued a Notice of Violation for the display to the Owner, which resulted in this application.

The Applicant is addressing the Notice of Violation with a proposal to limit outdoor display to conform with C-2 standards and to request the necessary use permit. The standards for outdoor display in the C-2 district, listed in Phoenix Zoning Ordinance §623.C.2, are:

- A maximum 300 square feet of display area can be located anywhere along the building except as noted in [subsection] b;
- No display or sale is permitted within ten linear feet of either side of the building entrance or exit;
- c. The depth, measured from the front façade of the building, may not exceed ten feet unless otherwise permitted by the Planning and Development Department upon a determination that a greater depth does not interfere with any pedestrian passage;
- Payment for the products displayed must occur indoors;
- Outdoor display shall not be located within any required setbacks or in the parking lot.

The proposed site plan, a copy of which is enclosed, meets these standards. The Applicant has removed tires from outdoor locations outside of the limited display area in front (west side) of the building.

The zoning adjustment application, a copy of which is enclosed, requests the following action:

Use permit to allow outdoor display of new merchandise. Use permit required. Phoenix Zoning Ordinance §623.C.2.

A public hearing on the application is scheduled for June 26, 2025 at 9:00 a.m. The hearing will be held in person at Phoenix City Hall, 200 West Washington Street, 1st Floor, Assembly Room C, Phoenix. There is no virtual option for a zoning adjustment hearing. The hearing agenda will be posted 15 days before the hearing on the Phoenix' Public Meeting Notices website: https://www.phoenix.gov/cityclerk/publicmeetings/notices Information will also be posted on signs on the Property. You may attend the hearing to learn about the case and to share your thoughts about it. 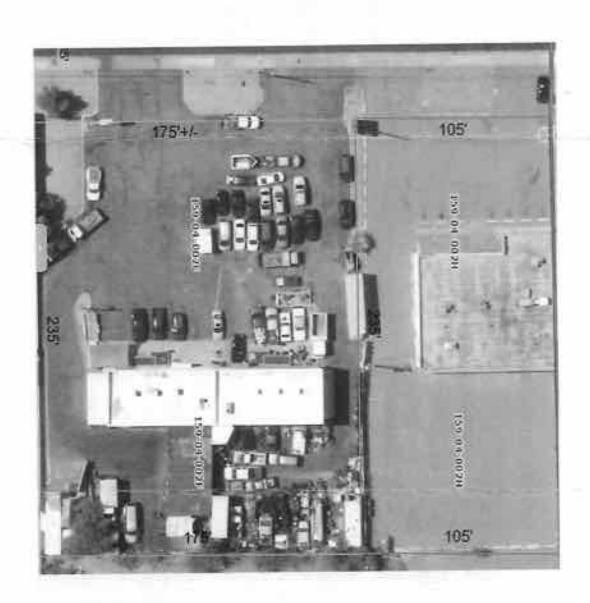

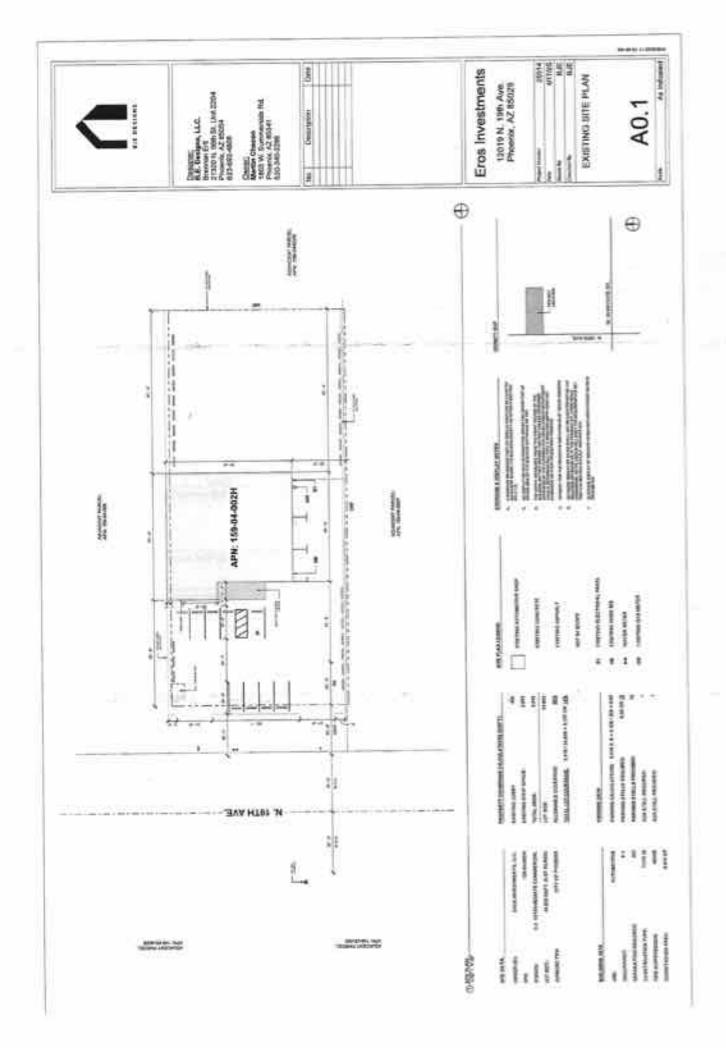
