**Answer:** Ford (1903 to Ferrari's 1940).
2. Which came first, the first recorded case of HIV or the last recorded case of smallpox?  
**Answer:** HIV (1959 to Smallpox's 1978)
3. Which happened first, the final execution by hanging in the UK or the final execution by guillotine in France?  
**Answer:** Hanging in the UK (1964 to France's 1977).
4. Which was first run by a human, the sub-4 minute mile or the sub-10 second 100m?  
**Answer:** Sub-4 minute mile (1954 by Roger Bannister to Jim Hines' 1968).
5. Which happened first, the assassination of Martin Luther King Jr or the birth of Barack Obama?  
**Answer:** Obama in 1961 (to MLK's 1968)

**Answer:** Paris

**Answer:** Cairo (30.0444° N to Las Vegas's 36.1716° N)
