

Key Vaccines & Eligibility During Pregnancy

Before Pregnancy:

MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella) Varicella (Chickenpox)

During pregnancy:

Whooping Cough (Tdap)

Flu

RSV

COVID-19

After pregnancy:

Any vaccine you are not up-to-date on, especially if breast feeding.





Where to get Vaccinated

- Reach out to your local DPH health department who offers low-cost vaccines.
- Visit the DPH website to find a provider near you:

- Contact your provider or pharmacy.
- Call the DPH Care Line at 855-472-3432

You may be eligible for free vaccines through the Vaccines for Children (VFC) program if your child is uninsured, underinsured, Medicaid-eligible, or American Indian/Alaska Native. Ask your provider if they participate in the VFC program.
