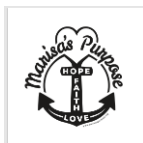
**Academic level:**

**Additional criteria:**

This \$1,000 scholarship is available to students who meet the following criteria:

- Graduating High School seniors who will enroll in an accredited University or Community College in the academic year of 2021-2022.
- Scholarship candidates must possess a history of raising drug or alcohol addiction awareness, as demonstrated by volunteer, educational, or professional experiences, or affected personally.
- Scholarship candidates must be in good academic standing with a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or above.
- The scholarship funds may be allocated toward tuition, books, or housing. The scholarship will not be issued until verification of enrollment into the educational institution of their choice. The funds must be used within six months of matriculation. Appropriate documentation (receipts or tuition payment confirmation) of how the funds were used must be submitted to Marisa's Purpose within six months after the fund dispersal.
