

Supplementary Articles of Incorporation
of
Blind Slough Finnish Evangelical
Lutheran Congregation.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS; That we, Charles Helkkinen, Henry Smith, and John Polso, the duly elected, qualified and acting trustees of Blind Slough Finnish Evangelical Lutheran Congregation, a corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Oregon, and as such trustees we have been instructed by unanimous vote of the members of said corporation at a meeting thereof held on the 14th day of January, 1926, pursuant to a notice duly made and given as prescribed by Section 7022 of Oregon Laws, to make, adopt, subscribe and file supplementary articles of incorporation of said corporation, and for said purpose, we do hereby make, adopt and subscribed the following supplementary articles of incorporation.

1.

That the name assumed by this church organization and by which it shall be known is Brownsmead Finnish Evangelical Lutheran Congregation, and that the duration of said incorporated church organization shall be perpetual.

2.

That the object of said church organization shall be to teach and promote the Christian religion, and to do and perform such good works as can be done by a church organization or religious society; and said church organization, as incorporated, by its trustees shall have the right and power to purchase, hold, mortgage, sell and dispose of real estate and personal property, as may be necessary or proper in carrying out the objects of this corporation, and generally to do and perform every and any act and thing necessary or convenient to carry into effect the objects aforesaid.

3.

That the estimated money value of property possessed by said church organization at the time of making these supplementary articles of incorporation is \$2500.00, and its only source of revenue consists of gifts and contributions by its members or others.

4.

That the title of the officers making and adopting these supplementary articles of incorporation is that of trustees of said church organization, and they and their successors in office are elected annually by a vote of the members of said society or organization, the annual election being held at 2 o'clock P. M. on the second Thursday of January each year.

5.

Said church organization or society is located at Brownsmead, Clatsop County, Oregon.
