# **About this workshop**

This course is intended for artists of all levels. The workshop can motivate artists into the adventures of painting outdoors "En Plein Air" using watercolor. Artists will enjoy a two-day, outdoors, on-site painting workshop around the Clayton, NY area in the 1000 Islands.

Kim Hoerster's instructional studio is in Georgetown, Texas, and offers watercolor and drawing classes online at KimHoerster.com. Kim has travelled throughout the US, and other countries painting En Plein Air as well as teaching indoors and outdoors workshops.

This Plein Air Workshop can be tailored to your skill level.

Kim loves teaching "newbie" beginners and has a course for beginning artists starting each January. She also wants to stimulate and encourage those who have more advanced skills.



Be sure to list your skill knowledge so that Kim can organize the class to meet the group's needs. Kim has helpful techniques to teach and simplify drawing, painting strategies, composition, selecting your painting spot, equipment, supplies, and more.

### **Couse Includes**

- Demonstrations by Kim using watercolor pigments.
- Group lectures and individual instruction
- Plein air painting sessions morning and afternoon.

Important: So Kim can better organize the group please state your skill level in both areas highlighted below:

### Watercolor skill level:

- BEGINNER I am brand new and have never learned watercolor techniques but want to learn the basics.
- INTERMEDIATE I have learned the basics in watercolor and feel comfortable with skills like a flat wash, graded wash, lifting out, dropping in, bleeding, dry brush, line work with a script brush, etc.

○ ADVANCED – I have been painting with watercolor for years, confident with skills, but will enjoy learning from a new instructor.

## Plein Air Skill Level:

Participants may paint in the medium of choice during the workshop but please let Kim know your plans. If you have never approached plein air, the best way is to start drawing outdoors. Kim can help you understand how to select a painting spot, composition, how much subject to add into your drawing, thumbnail benefits, and more. If you already grasp plein air basics, but new to watercolor skills, Kim will gladly encourage you further combining the two. If you are only interested in oil, pastels, or other mediums Kim will help you with plein air composition concepts and more, but the workshop will focus on watercolor. Kim is a watercolorist.

- I am a brand-new beginner to painting outdoors. I would like to learn the basics of how to get started. State if you are a beginner or advanced in drawing skills.
- I have tried painting outdoors with little success. I have drawing skills and would like to like to learn the basics of adding watercolor outdoors.
- I have painted plein air numerous times but with a different medium than watercolor and would like to understand the changeover to watercolor.
- I have been painting en plein air many years and would enjoy ideas from a new instructor. I would
  like to stay with my medium of choice instead of watercolor but still learn ideas related to
  composition, values, etc. Describe further your PLEIN AIR skill level and where you desire to improve.



- Tripod setup for Plein Air watercolor (not a table easel) Kim uses En Plein Air Pro Travelers Series for watercolor. The black shelf NOT the attached palette. I like to set my own folding palette on the black shelf that has the hole for the water cup. The attached top shelf is nice if you want to sit a block of paper. Kim has an attached Cora-plast (corrugated plastic) home made portfolio instead of the top shelf. Once you see hers, if interested, she will gladly teach you how to make one.
- · Palette Creative Mark folding palette or any palette that fits your painting setup
- · Brushes brushes you normally work with or see Kims
- Paper Suggested watercolor paper. Kim's prefers Arches OR Saunders ROUGH 140 lb.
   Please only use PROFESSIONAL quality paper that is 100% COTTON no matter the brand.
- · Water, water container, sack cloth cup towel or paper towels, spray bottle.
- · beaked visor or hat, sunscreen, sturdy shoes.
- A "view finder" home-made, or available at art supply stores & online or your hands.
- Optional: Plein air umbrella (Kim has BestBrella that attaches to her tripod leg)
- Optional: Folding/collapsible chair (Kim has a hunting 3 legged stool)


