The Callaway Community Foundation Fund reviews applications twice a year. Applications are continually available at nebraskahometown.org/fund/Callaway and must be received no later than 5 p.m. on the closing date for the cycle the application is to be considered.

What We Fund

The Callaway Community Foundation Fund restricts its support to 501(c)(3) organizations, government entities or other types of organizations using the funds for a charitable purpose. If your organization is not a 501(c)(3) or government organization, please contact us as you prepare your grant application so we can verify that the purpose is charitable.

We encourage grant requests for projects or programs that are consistent with our vision, mission and values and:

- Will have a broad impact on the quality of life for a significant number of people
- Propose ways to address community issues and problems
- Leverage other sources of support
- Encourage others to get involved in addressing community needs
- Are creative in their approach to solving problems or capturing opportunities

- Are responsive to changing or emerging community needs
- Help develop community leadership
- Engage young people in the community
- Support innovative approaches to economic development
- Are sustainable over time

What We Don't Fund

The Callaway Community Foundation Fund does not make grants to individuals, for political purposes including lobbying or legislative activity, to retire indebtedness, for payment of interest or taxes or for granting. We do not usually give priority to funding for:

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- Operating or maintenance expenses
- Membership fees
- Banquet or luncheon expenses
- Ticket sales for charitable fund-raising expenses
- Religious organizations for religious purposes

The Process

Submit your grant application in hard copy. After we receive your completed application, our Grant Committee will review the applications. At that point, we may request more information from you. The Grant Committee will make recommendations for funding to the Fund Advisory Committee. The Callaway Grant Committee is made up of involved community members who live and work in Callaway. We will notify you of our decision as soon as possible.

If you receive a grant, you must submit a final report within 60 days after the completion of the project or program for which you received funding. Our grant reporting form is available from nebraskahometown.org/fund/Callaway or Great Western Bank, Nebraska State Bank or Dynamic Insurance Services, all located in Callaway.

Additional Information

We cannot guarantee that every proposal will be funded or you will receive the full amount you requested. The Callaway Community Foundation Fund accepts only one grant request per organization per grant period. Organizations that receive grants during a previous grant making cycle are not eligible for the upcoming grant cycle unless the funds have been expended AND the organization is requesting funds for a separate project. The final report is due before an additional grant will be funded.

Each grant request will be reviewed and evaluated on its own merit based on the contents of the application. For this reason, it is important to provide clear and complete responses to all information requested.
