## **Check Before Leaving the Hangar Check List:**

o Is the control lock in the Yoke?

(Reasons: 1) good practice, 2) needed for cross-country, 3) I have trouble finding it every time it is not placed in the yoke column...I do use it often for X-country...Ron)

- O Will the door clear the Prop?
- o Is the fuel selector on RT or LT tank?
- O Did you dip the tanks (useful for the next user)?
- O Did you take pictures of the Hobbs and TT meters?
- Put before-flight oil level on Dispatch sheet.
- o Are all seatbelts buckled across the seats?
- o Are the harnesses stowed above the doors (both sides)?
- o Is the battery maintainer plugged in?
- Are bugs cleaned off leading edges and windscreen (warmer Wx)?
- All your stuff removed? (Mainly papers, trash, food, etc.)
   There will be a small bin for anyone asking, so you can leave glasses (I'm guilty), etc. in the hangar. I will purchase bins that are large enough for my Ram mount, too.
- Make sure that you note any damage to the hangar and contents. "Squawk" any items not done by previous user.
