

## Cleaning Information

### Rags/cloths:

- Gray-white & gray cloths are for cleaning the airframe.
- White & blue microfiber cloths are for windows. Always wipe windows in the direction of airflow.
- Put dirty rags in the bag designated for “rags”. I clean them a couple of times then relegate them to wiping the oil dipstick, or throw them away.
- There is also a bagged garbage can for all trash. If it gets full, please empty it. Do not leave items that have had food in them.

### Cleaners:

- Red/White Prist spray can: use on windows; does not leave a film.
- Green spray can: use on windows, but it leaves a film. Of all the cleaners on the shelf, this stuff is the best for bugs.
- Hand-spray bottles: Rinse before filling; fill with distilled water, a little vinegar and a few drops of Dawn (Ingredients on shelves). Good for cleaning windows and removing the film, but it leaves the windows wet.
- Gallon jug & manual spray bottle of “Wash-n-Wax”. Please feel free to use it with gray rags to clean the airplane.
- Large broom: please broom if large quantity of debris has blown in.
- Bucket, nozzle and hose are for air frame wash. Key for hose bibb is hanging on sign near door opener.

### Other items on the shelves:

- Stoddards Solvent & Mineral Spirits will clean grease off wheel pants and underside of fuselage.
- Chocks, plastic tool case, & tie downs are for your use if you go on a X-Country trip.
- Water/Beverages: for any member’s use. Hope to get fridge someday.
- The instruments on the shelves came off N759ZT, and work.
