Operating Rules & Regulations & Preferred Rate Policy

2020 POLICY REGARDING HOURLY RATES for N759ZT & N735LC

- 1) **Preferred rate, \$166/hr wet,** applies to pilots committing to flying 24 hours per year (see more below).
- 2) **Standard rate, \$186/hr wet,** will apply to those who do not commit to 24 hours.
- 3) **Angel flight rate** will be **\$135** per hour.

Additional information pertaining to these rates:

- 1) **Preferred:** Required to fly 7 hours each quarter. From January 1 through March 31 the commitment is 3 hours; total 24 annually.
- 2) **Angel:** Preferred members are eligible for this rate after they have been a Preferred member for 60 days.
- 3) The minimum daily overnight usage is 2 hours per 24 hour period.
- 4) Only Preferred club members will be able to retain SWOF gate keys. There will be a common key in a lockbox, location TBD.

Insurance: CV Starr Insurance Company

Aircraft Liability Limits: \$1,000,000 Combined Single Limit including \$100,000 per passenger sublimit

Physical Damage Deductibles: Single Engine \$250 not in Motion; \$1000 in motion

Additional Coverage, all included:

- Medical Payments each person: \$5,000 / \$20,000 each occurrence
- Baggage Coverage Endorsement: \$3,000 per person
- Student and Renter Pilot Liability Endorsement: \$100,000 each occurrence
- Emergency or Unexpected Landing Endorsement (5% of the insured value)
- Lienholder Interest Endorsement (Breach of Warranty)
- Owner / Lessor Endorsement
- Premises Amendment Endorsement

Other Important Aircraft & SWOF Club Information:

The concept of flying clubs is to share in the cost of an airplane, thus getting a lower rate than otherwise available. SWOF strives to make this experience as close to owning an airplane as possible. Part of that concept is to participate in the cleaning of the airplane and premises. To that end, you are asked to abide by all checklists, including removing trash from the airplane and hangar. The airplane will need external cleaning, so, from time-to-time, and based on need, we will schedule a time on a Saturday morning to meet and clean the aircraft and to discuss any matters that come to mind. A continental breakfast will be served, compliments of the airplane owner. And finally, maintenance is done "On Condition", same as other Part 91 airplanes.
