Love Dogs, but not ready to adopt??

The vast majority of the dogs WAG rescues come from other shelters that are forced to euthanize due to a lack of resources and space.

Many of these dogs have had a life of neglect. In many cases, our shelter provides them with the safest most comfortable life they have known. However, shelter life is still a stressful environment, even in the best of circumstances.

For those dogs that are highly stressed at the kennel, it is very hard for them to be truly "seen" by potential adopters. They may exhibit behaviors in the kennel environment that do not manifest in a home. Therefore, WAG tries very hard to have as many dogs as possible placed in Foster homes while they await adoption.

Fostering is a truly rewarding way to help dogs in need transition from shelter life to a permanent home.

As a Foster "parent" for a WAG dog, you will be provided with the necessities of caring for a dog. Food, medical care and medications are provided. All you need is an appropriate living situation and lots of love!

There are SO MANY stories from Fosters expressing the joy and life changing experience that comes from Fostering.

Is it heartbreaking to give them up when a permanent home is found? Honestly, it can bring a range of emotions. But knowing that WAG is very careful about vetting potential adopters, will give you a feeling of security that your foster dog will be loved and cared for in their new family. The delight of experiencing your foster dog finding that forever family will outweigh the feelings of loss when they are adopted. Then, you are possibly in a position to help a new dog and the life saving cycle of rescue, foster and adoption can continue to save dogs.
