

## K–2 Inclusive Resource Guide

**Book:** *The Three Little Pigs and the Not-So-Big-Bad Wolf* by Clarissa Willis

**Targets:** Literal WH questions + vocabulary (**food drive, share, note, potluck**) **Format:** 10 questions, **3 answer choices** each

### Quick Teacher Script (2 minutes)

- “Today we will listen to a story and answer **WH questions**.”
- “Our special words are: **food drive, share, note, potluck**.”
- “You can answer by **saying it, pointing, or using AAC**.”

### Target Vocabulary (student-friendly)

- **food drive** = a time when people collect food to help others
- **share** = give some to others
- **note** = a short message written on paper
- **potluck** = a party where everyone brings food

### Literal WH Questions (use picture choices)

1. **Who** are the main characters?  
A) three little pigs B) three little kittens C) three little ducks
2. **Who** comes to the pigs’ door?  
A) a wolf B) a dinosaur C) a dragon
3. **What** is taped to the wall?  
A) a **note** B) a picture C) a map
4. **What** does the note announce?  
A) a forest-wide **food drive** B) a birthday party C) a snow day
5. **When** is the food drive?  
A) tomorrow B) last week C) next year
6. **What** does Pig Two do at night?  
A) leaves food by the gate to **share** B) hides all the food C) throws the food away
7. **Who** comes with the wolf in the morning?  
A) a bear B) a shark C) a horse
8. **Where** is the potluck?  
A) in the meadow B) in the ocean C) at the zoo
9. **When** is the potluck?  
A) tonight at six B) tomorrow at noon C) next month
10. **What** do pigs One and Three say at the end?  
A) “We’ve been selfish.” B) “We are moving away.” C) “We will never share.”

- Student points to the answer (or selects on AAC).
- Optional: student also points to the matching **vocabulary card** (food drive/share/note/potluck).
