Pointe aux Barques Lighthouse Society—2018— A Great Year

This has been an exciting year for the Pointe aux Barques Lighthouse Society in Lighthouse County park as we have had a steady flow of visitors through the museum and grounds. We were able to complete a number of projects that have spiffed up the lighthouse an area. The tower has been painted for the first time in 11 years. The oil house was also painted. We have also made the grounds more visitor friendly with the addition of memorial benches donated by the families of Peg Damrau and Roger Earl Affholter. Friends of the lighthouse also donated a bench to be placed outside of the Gift Shop for the husbands of our shoppers! In addition, students at the Huron County Tech Center made a “bike” rack for our two wheeled visitors.

Tremendous support was provided by the Huron County Road Commission along with County and Park staff to make this year one to remember. Our annual festival was great again this year with kudos going out to Flight Care for flying in their helicopter and providing our visitors the opportunity to see and learn more about the important work they do. We had a lot of support from the Port Hope Firemen and the fine people from the AMVETS. We had over 60 volunteers to assist in all aspects of the festival including planning and execution of multiple tasks needed to run a successful festival. It is truly becoming a community effort! The Tower Climb has become a visitor favorite with the Society being able to add climbing days, again a result of our wonderful volunteers giving so much of their time. In addition, Lighthouse park has become a favorite spot for Geocachers with at least 6 geocaching

sites available for treasure hunting!!

New fund raising efforts have been instituted for the Pointe aux Barques Life Saving Station. The money raised will be utilized to install new roofing for the LSS. 
