As you are aware, the federal Protection of Pupil Rights Amendment (20 U.S.C. § 1232h)
requires a school to excuse a student from any survey containing questions about sex
behavior or attitudes; illegal, anti-social, self-incriminating, or demeaning behavior; religious
practices, affiliations, or beliefs of the student or the student's parent; or any of the other
topics listed in the law.
This letter serves as notice to opt my child out of all surveys that contain questions regarding
sex behavior or attitudes; illegal, anti-social, self-incriminating, or demeaning behavior;
religious practices, affiliations, or beliefs of the student or the student's parent; or the other
topics listed 20 U.S.C. § 1232h(c)(1)(B).
Please confirm in writing that you have received this notification and inform me of the
procedures the school will use to ensure that my child will be protected from any survey
containing questions about sex behavior or attitudes; illegal, anti-social, self-incriminating, or
demeaning behavior; religious practices, affiliations, or beliefs of the student or the student's
parent; or any of the other topics listed in the law.
