As you are aware, the federal Protection of Pupil Rights Amendment (20 U.S.C. § 1232h) requires a school to excuse a student from any survey containing questions about sex behavior or attitudes; illegal, anti-social, self-incriminating, or demeaning behavior; religious practices, affiliations, or beliefs of the student or the student's parent; or any of the other topics listed in the law.
