MRF parsing reports are custom generated for a client's NPI and CPT requests on a per-insurance basis. Please indicate below which insurance company you would like analyzed, the providers you would like included in the report, and which CPT's you would like data for. The pricing structure is:

Policy on Pricing:

Reports are priced at \$1250 and include 4 NPI's (your own + 3 competitors) and 5 CPT's. Additional NPI's are priced at \$300/NPI and additional CPT's are priced at \$150/CPT. The Transparency in Coverage (TiC) rule only mandates that reimbursement data for a certain NPI/CPT pair be published in the event that said NPI bills said CPT >20x per calendar month. This means that occasionally certain requested data may not be available. In the event that a certain CPT returns no data across any of the requested NPI's, a discount of \$150 per affected CPT will be applied. In the event that no data is found for any NPI's/CPT's, a full refund will be issued.

Disclaimer and Client Agreement:

Please note: 1) The Transparency in Coverage (TiC) rule requires publishing of both an "In Network" and "Allowed Amounts" machine readable file (MRF) with the later catering to reimbursement of providers not in-network with that insurance. The service associated with this requisition does not parse the allowed amounts MRF. 2) Occasionally, multiple sub-plans will be reported within the In Network files. Note that this is the case with UHC and BCBS, but not Presbyterian. In these instances, data from all of the sub-plans will be reported at no extra charge. 3) The standard file format for MRF's is JSON or JSON/GZIP, however, YAML and XML are allowed, but rarely used. In the unlikely event that the file format changes between submission of this requisition and return of the final report (thereby requiring a full re-write of the parsing software), the client acknowledges that the requisition will be cancelled pending software updates. 4) These reports are confidential and may not be shared, transferred or sold to anyone except the intended recipient.
