Trexo Robotic Home Application Scholarship Policy

Description

The Kourageous Karter Foundation aims to make life better for medically complex kids and the people who love them. More than that, we aim to make the world more aware, accessible, and inclusive for children with disabilities and medical complexities.

In our opinion, walking is an experience every child deserves, regardless of disability. We believe in the health and social benefits brought about by the medical technology, Trexo Robotics Gait Training system. We aim to provide a selected family with one 12-month lease of the Trexo Home system.

Criteria

- 1. Must complete assessment by Trexo Robotics to determine eligibility (they will determine if the child is an appropriate candidate).**

How do I know if my child is an appropriate candidate?

Once selected, you will receive an email with the assessment form. Here, you will fill out further information about your child, upload videos, and measurements. To complete the assessment you will need a measuring tape and access to a device with video recording capabilities.

Trexo will walk you through the set-up & training to ensure the device is set-up for your child's needs on a live video call.

The initial set-up and training takes time. It is much easier if there are two people that can help with training and set-up. If possible, please ensure set-up is scheduled for a time when two adults can be present, and 3 hours available.

Rifton Pacer

The Rifton Dynamic Pacer is not included with the purchase of a Trexo Home, but is required to use this technology. They use a standard off the shelf Dynamic pacer and install the system on it. You would need to obtain your pacer prior to the delivery of your Trexo Home to ensure we can provide the fitting and training with a fully assembled system. If you need a Rifton Dynamic Pacer and cannot obtain one separately, we can assist you with the purchase in addition to the Trexo. Please make sure you have received the recommended size and accessories from Trexo before you place a Rifton order. You will receive this once you complete the assessment and receive approval for the use of the Trexo.

Trial Period

Once you receive your Trexo Home, complete with set-up and training, the recipient will begin a 14-day trial period through Trexo. During this time you'll want to be sure the child tolerates and benefits from this technology, and that you (the family) wants to follow through with the commitment to use it (see general usage guidelines).

Internet and Video Access

In order to set up the Trexo Home, it will require a device that enables you to videochat via Zoom with the Trexo team virtually. Having access to their chat app, and Zoom consultations is a requirement for eligibility.

Warranty

The lease of the Trexo will include the standard warranty agreement. Any cost related to the Trexo (i.e. repairs or replacements) that is not covered in the warranty will not be covered by KKF.

Criteria for Approval

The following will be used as criteria for approval:

- 1) Application was filled out completely
- 2) Child was determined an appropriate candidate per Trexo team's assessment
- 3) Demonstrates financial need

The following terms will be used for disapproval:

- 1) Application is on behalf of school or therapy center (must be for individual at this time)
- 2) Nominee was determined an inappropriate candidate per Trexo's assessment process
- 3) Application is incomplete
- 4) Applicant has not provided any information demonstrates financial need
