We have many very severe allergies this year.

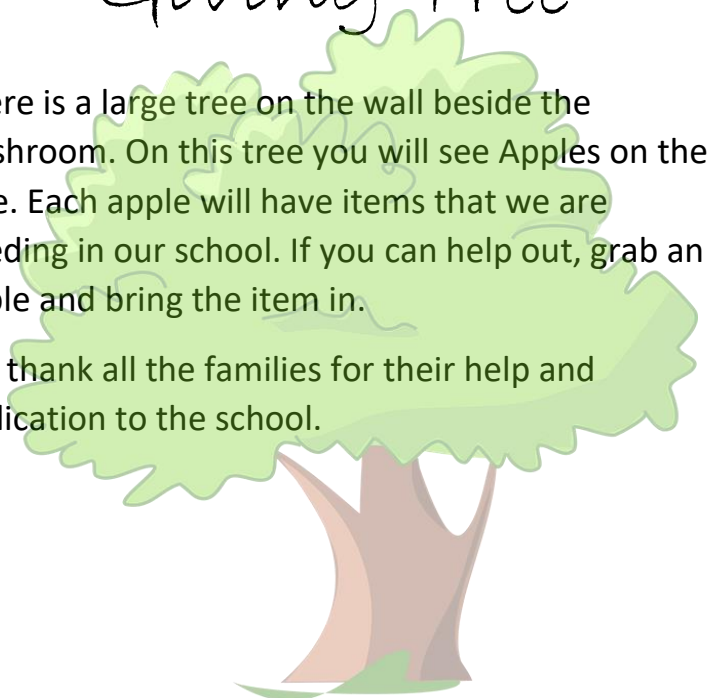
Snacks CANNOT contain the following – PEANUT, NUTS, EGG, MILK, & SOY products.
