Regular Meeting May 5, 2025

**CALL TO ORDER** - The Port Allegany Borough Council met on May 5, 2025 at the Borough Council Chambers. Katie Dynda made a motion to approve Resolution 2025-6 Updating Ordinance 453 regarding member contributions to the CBRA. Caleb Benson seconded. Motion carried unanimously.
