East Polk SWCD will particiapte, initiate and promote educational opportunities related to the Wetland conservatio Act, wetland issues, and other natural resource concerns. Methods used to accomplish this will be, but are not limited to, articles in the District's newsletter, area news publications, radio interviews and presentations. The East Polk SWCD will have at least two articles a year in the District newsletter relating to WCA and/or wetland issues. East Polk SWCD will provide a wetland-related learning statio at its Rydell Education Days. East Polk SWCD will continue to paticiapte annually in the Minnesota Water Festival for fourth-grade students. East Polk SWCD will also use the WCA Program to promote the preservation and enhancement of natural resources within the Glacial Lake Agassiz Beach Ridge area as outlined in the Polk County Local WAter Management plan, Priority Condern 3.

Actual Results:

East Polk SWCD staff promoted educational and informational opportunities related to wetlands and the West Conservation Act by publishing articles in the District's LakeLeader newslaetter, which was distributed twice during the reporting year to approximately 1100 lakeshore property landowners on Union, Sarah, Maple Lakes, as well as other requesting parties. The District also provided a wetland learning station at the Rydell Education Day, which is a hands-on educational activity for seventh-grade students in East Polk County. Approximately 100 seventh grade students from Win-E-Mac and Fosston Schools attended. East Polk SWCD staff also participated in the planning and organization of the Northwest Minnesota Water Festival. This program is a water resources based, hands-on educational opportunity for fourth-grade students in northwest Minnesota. Over the two-day festival, over 630 students participated.
