Dogwood (Redosier)	6-8'	Full sun to partial shade, rapid growing with red branches
Juneberry	4-6'	Full sun, purple/black fruit, flowers in spring
Common Lilac	10-12'	Full sun, Equal spread, purple flowers in spring
Nannyberry	12-15'	Full sun to partial shade White flowers in spring with black fruit
Hazelnut (American)	8-15'	Full sun to partial shade, edible nut
Highbush Cranberry	8-12'	Sun to partial shade, equal spread, white flowers, red berries
Elderberry	5-12'	Sun to partial shade, small dark blue berry
Nanking Cherry	6-10'	Full sun, red cherry like drupe, winter hardy
Common Chokecherry	20-30'	Full sun to partial shade, very hardy, suckering, red berries

Crabapple (Red Splendor)	15-20'	Full sun, rosy red flowers, small red apple
Crabapple (Siberian)	25-30'	Full sun, white flowers, small yellow or red apple
American Plum	12-20'	Full sun, suckering shrub, very hardy with fruit
Flame Willow	13-15'	Full sun to slight shade, bright red, yellow, orange branches
Golden Willow	15-80'	Full sun to part shade, golden branches, fast growing, moist soil

Red Maple	40-60'	Sun to part shade red leaves in fall
Sugar Maple	60-70'	Sun to part shade, bright red leaves in the fall
Silver Maple	50-70'	Full sun, pale green leaves with silver underneath, yellow in fall
Bur Oak	70-80'	Sun, rough bark, drought tolerant
Red Oak	70-80'	Sun, moderate to fast growth, red leaves
American Linden (Basswood)	50-60'	Full sun, spread is half its height, large leaves
Hackberry	30-50'	Full sun, produces small purple drupes
Paper Birch	50-70'	Sun to part shade, very hardy, fast growing
Eastern Cottonwood	75-100'	Full sun, fast growing, good for shelter belts
Quaking Aspen	40-50'	Full sun, good for shelter belts, fast growing
Conifers		
White Spruce	40-60'	Partial sun to shade, dark gray bark
Black Hills Spruce	20-50'	Sun, dark green foliage, resistant to winter injury
Balsam Fir	40-60'	Shade tolerant, smooth bark, tapering
Eastern White Cedar	50-60'	Shade tolerant, similar to arborvitae
Red Pine	60-80'	Sun, reddish brown bark, dry soil
Colorado Blue Spruce	30-90'	Full sun, blue needles, used for shelterbelts or ornamental
Techny Arborvitae	15-20'	Full sun to partial shade, compact, good for hedges
Rocky Mountain Juniper	30-40'	Sun to partial shade, aromatic dense foliage
