As a foundational program for Clackamas High School Cheer, we focus on preparing athletes for the next level through proper technique, strong work ethic, and pride in being part of the Cavalier Cheer community.

Through effort, attitude, and commitment, we aim to build not only strong athletes, but strong teammates—creating a program that continues to grow and sets the standard for future Cavaliers.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Current status of the Cavalier Junior Cheer season has changed, as we will be offering Sideline only at this time due to a shortage in coaches. We are hoping things change and that we'll be able to offer competition in the fall/winter!

The number of cheerleaders placed on each team, as well as structures, will be determined by the Cavalier Junior Cheer coaching staff.

The Cavalier Junior Cheer is a feeder program for Clackamas High School. Registration is currently open to:

- Mini Team - athletes in K-2nd grade (TBD on status of the 26-27 competition season)
- Youth Team - athletes in 3-5th grade
- Junior Team - athletes in 6-8th grade

ESTIMATED TIME COMMITMENT

The following is an estimation of the practice schedule and expected time commitment for Cavalier Junior Cheer. Please make note of the commitment level when choosing to join Cavalier Junior Cheer. As a member of our program, we expect full participation in all activities until the end of the season.

- A detailed calendar of events will be provided in the BAND app
- Cheerleaders are strongly encouraged to attend all summer camps and practices.
- Please notify the coach in writing as soon as you know of all summer vacations and days the cheerleader will not be at practice or other events

TUMBLING

Tumbling is an integral part of the success of our program. Advancement of tumbling skills will be an expectation for each athlete. Tumbling instruction will be Thursday evenings at Clackamas High School.

Disclaimer: Cheerleading is a very active sport as with any sport, there is a potential for injury. Jumping, tumbling, and stunting are regular parts of practices and games. Cavalier Junior Cheer emphasizes safety at all time, but injuries may occur. It is imperative that parents and cheerleaders understand/are aware of this potential risk.

FINANCIAL OBLIGATION

Registration fees are due at registration/prior to the first practice, with other participation and uniform fees due in monthly payments.

The total cost for the 5-month season (June–October) is approximately \$1150 for athletes new to the program. When broken down, this averages about \$200 a month for coaching, facility use, tumbling, uniforms, and overall program expenses. As a nonprofit program, all fees are reinvested directly into supporting our athletes and providing a quality, well-structured experience.

Fees for the season may be subjected due to fundraising events planned, so please do not stress about this. We will have numerous fundraising opportunities as well as sponsorships in the future!

If, for any reason, you choose to leave the program (or are asked to leave), any monies in your account will be forfeited and put into the general fund. The general fund will be used to pay for additional items for athletes, the practice area, or towards future events.

Invoices will be generated to go out on the first of each month. Due to increased fees in card processing, a 3.7% fee will be added to each invoice to cover the fees charged to Cavalier Junior Cheer. Having the ability to accept payments online has been a huge time-saver for all involved, but unfortunately our non-profit program is not in a position to cover the processing fees at this time.

PAYMENT SCHEDULE CONTINUED

All required gear must be paid in full by the August statement deadline. Gear will only be distributed to athletes whose accounts are up to date by this date. All fees must be paid in full by November 1, 2026. A \$50 late fee will be applied to any account with an outstanding balance after this date.

Continued participation in practices and competitions may be impacted if accounts are not kept current.

SIDELINE GEAR

For the 2026-2027 season, everyone will receive new: practice shirts, poms, and bows.

*Additional gear includes personalized jacket, personalized backpack, and uniform. The jacket and backpack do not need to be purchased if your athlete already has them from a previous year. Uniform tops (shell and liner) are the same as last year, but we are going with a different skirt.

Families will be required to provide the following for the upcoming season:

- All-black shorts - no undergarments showing
- All-black leggings - no logos, full length
- All-white no-show socks
- All-white cheer shoes - ideally the Nike Sideline IV Cheerleading shoes available at Dicks Sporting Goods in youth and adult sizes

FUNDRAISING

Fundraising is an important factor in making cheer fun yet affordable. Some future fundraising opportunities we are looking into include Car Washes, Chipotle, Willamette Pies, BottleDrop, and Tony's Garden Center! Some fundraisers will be based on individual participation and will go directly towards individual cheer accounts, while others will collectively go towards the Cavalier Junior Cheer account to pay for competition costs, scholarships, new equipment, and whatever else may come up.

REFUND POLICY

- 100% refund of fees when canceling prior to July 1st, with \$25 administrative fee assessed.
- 50% refund of fees when canceling prior to August 1st, with \$50 administrative fee assessed.
- No refunds will be issued after August 1st.

INCLUSION & ATHLETE SUPPORT POLICY

Cavalier Junior Cheer is committed to providing an inclusive and respectful environment for all athletes. Reasonable accommodations may be made to support participation, provided they align with the safety standards, structure, and expectations of the program.

Cheerleading requires the ability to follow direction, work as part of a team, and maintain awareness in a physically active environment. Athlete safety is our top priority. Accommodations and modifications—including adjustments to roles or skill participation—will be considered on a case-by-case basis to ensure a safe and positive experience for all. Cavalier Junior Cheer does not provide one-on-one supervision or specialized medical care and cannot implement accommodations that fundamentally alter the program or compromise safety.

Open communication with families is essential. Cavalier Junior Cheer reserves the right to determine appropriate placement and level of participation based on an athlete's ability to safely meet program expectations.

RULES AND EXPECTATIONS OVERVIEW

Being part of Cavalier Junior Cheer means showing up with commitment, accountability, and pride. Every athlete plays an important role in the safety, success, and culture of this program. The following expectations are in place to ensure we operate as a strong, unified team.

Commitment & Attendance

- Cheer is a full-season commitment. Athletes are expected to be on time and to attend all practices, games, performances, and team events.
- Only illness or true emergencies will be considered excused absences. Conflicts must be communicated in advance with coaches. Consistent attendance is critical, and excessive absences may impact participation or standing on the team.

Practice & Game Day Standards

- Athletes should arrive prepared, focused, and ready to work in correct attire.
- Represent the program with professionalism at all times
- Game days are a performance environment. Athletes are expected to remain present with the team—no socializing with friends or family during game responsibilities.

Appearance & Uniform

- A consistent, clean, and performance-ready appearance is required.
- Uniforms must be worn completely and correctly at all times. Athletes are responsible for the care and upkeep of all issued items.
- Athletes are expected to maintain a respectful and professional presence while in uniform.
- Appearance expectations:
 - Hair must be secured out of the face and styled as directed (per NFHS/OCCA rules)
 - Makeup for competitions must match the team standard if agreed upon
 - Nails must be short and safe for stunting (no acrylics or press-ons), no polish for performances (per NFHS/OCCA rules)
 - No jewelry of any kind, including cartilage or belly button piercings (per NFHS/OCCA rule)

Conduct & Team Culture

Athletes are expected to represent Cavalier Junior Cheer with respect, integrity, and a team-first mindset at all times. This includes:

- Respecting coaches, teammates, and school staff
- Demonstrating positive behavior in person and on social media
- Supporting teammates and contributing to a strong team culture

Negative behavior, poor sportsmanship, or actions that reflect poorly on the program will not be tolerated.

Accountability

Each athlete is responsible for their role on the team.

Failure to meet expectations—including attendance, behavior, or preparation—may result in consequences such as reduced participation, suspension from performances, or removal from the team. Our goal is not punishment, but to uphold a standard that allows every athlete and the program as a whole to succeed. This program is built on commitment, consistency, and culture. When everyone shows up and does their part, we create something we can all be proud of.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF PARTICIPATION

- I will maintain open communication with the coaches at all times regarding scheduling conflicts, illness, injuries, and absences.
- I will follow the directions given by the coaches. I understand and agree that coaches make all program decisions.
- I understand that coaches are happy to discuss any athlete's weaknesses to help them improve, but that the coach must also consider what is best for the team as a whole.
- I understand and agree to the payment plan and will stay up to date with my own cheer account.
- I understand that once any uniform or gear items have been purchased, no refunds are guaranteed to be issued for these items.
- I understand and agree to the calendar given and realize changes can be made.
- I understand that I am responsible for learning cheer material from missed practices using the videos provided outside of practice time.
- I understand that I am expected to contribute to a positive team environment. Negative attitudes, gossip, or disrespectful communication towards teammates, coaches, or the program are not acceptable and may result in disciplinary action.
- I understand that jewelry of any kind is not allowed to be worn while at cheer practices and events. I also understand that if I get a new piercing, I must remove it for all cheer practice and events, and that I cannot tape over my new piercing or use plastic spaces.

Submitting your registration is your acknowledgement that you, as a parent/guardian, and your cheerleader, have read this document and agree to abide by these standards and are ready to participate in the Cavalier Junior Cheer program.
