ILLNESS POLICY

The Community Care Facility Act and Childcare Regulations for the Province of British Columbia set out health and safety standards for all licensed care facilities for children. We know that outbreaks of disease in childcare facilities are not only a medical problem, but they can also cause disruptions to staff, parents, and children and result in serious financial problems for all parties involved. Your cooperation in managing the spread of illness in the facility will help decrease the disruptions and problems for all involved.

Children are not permitted to attend Simply Fun Childcare Centers when they are ill or if your child:

- Has a rash
- Has a fever
- Has any nasal secretion where the caregiver must blow the child's nose more than once an hour during the day.
- Has vomited in the last 24 hours
- Has had diarrhea in the last 24 hours
- Is discharging mucus from their nose or mouth when sneezing or coughing
- Has been on antibiotics for less than 24 hours
- Has any discharge from the eyes

<u>Special note regarding colds</u>: Even though your child's nasal secretion may be clear, young children are constantly putting toys and hands in their mouth and spreading the discharge to everything they come in contact with. The caregiver is unable to maintain nose wiping constantly throughout the day. During this time, if your child remains at home resting for 2-3 days, the cold usually will go away quickly without developing into an infection which may spread to the other families attending. The Childcare Licensing Regulations are in place to protect the health and safety of all children and their families enrolled in the facility. Compromising the illness policy can place the other children at risk and can also cause the facility license to be in jeopardy.

Any outbreaks of a communicable illness contracted by two or more children or staff within a 48-hour period must be reported to the health authorities and may result in a temporary closure of the facility.

Please do not return your child to the Childcare Centers until your child is free of all the above symptoms.
