## Tree Species Descriptions

**Colorado Blue Spruce:** A slower, but most popular conifer. Narrow to broad pyramidal outline with horizontal stiff branches. Needles range from dark green to silver blue. Excellent for ornamental and windbreak plantings. Mature height is 40-60'.



**Bald Cypress:** A long-lived, pyramidal conifer (cone-bearing tree) which grows 100-120 feet tall. Old trees develop a wide, spreading base that narrows up the trunk with diameters as thick as 3-6'. Although it looks like a needled evergreen (same family as redwoods) in summer, it is deciduous ("bald" as the common name suggests).



**Norway Spruce:** One of the fastest growing spruce trees. Slender trunk with short drooping branches forming a very narrow pyramidal shape. Used for windbreaks, grows on most sites except where soil is water-soaked. Mature height is 80-100'.



**Red Osier Dogwood:** A loose, spreading, multi-stemmed shrub, 6-12 ft. tall, with conspicuous red twigs. Dense, flat-topped clusters of creamy-white blossoms are followed by umbrella-shaped clusters of pea-sized white berries. Autumn foliage is colorful. Redosier is deciduous.



**Black Chokeberry:** A dependable small to medium sized shrub with upright, mounded habit. Small clusters of white flowers in spring are followed by glossy black fruit. Dark green foliage turns reddish-purple in the fall.



**Black Cherry:** Moderate to rapid grower that will reach 50-60'. Clusters of white flowers from April to June. Fruit will appear June to November as dark purple, small clusters of berries.



**Black Walnut:** A valuable timber tree for veneer and furniture wood. Unlike other hardwood it grows well in most locations. Has delicious nuts.



**Pin Oak:** Pyramidal tree with glossy dark green leaves that change to bronze or red in the fall. Dried, brown leaves remain on the tree for much of the winter. Light brown acorns provide food for a wide range of animals. Prefers moist, rich, acidic, well-drained soil. Will tolerate clay soil and standing water for a short period. Mature height 40-50'.



**Bur Oak:** Bur oak is a large, deciduous tree with a very wide, open crown. Usually wider than tall, the tree can exceed 100 ft. in height and width. The massive trunk supports heavy, horizontal limbs and rough, deep-ridged bark.



**Red Bud:** Extremely popular small landscape tree that grows to 25-35'. Clusters of rosy pink flowers appear in April. Reddish-purple leaves change to dark green then to yellow.



**Sugar Maple:** A large ornamental shade tree. Small red flowers in spring and brilliant red fall colors. Tolerates wet, swampy areas or lime soil.



**Swamp White Oak:** A rapid growing tree with a mature height of 60-70'. The crown shape and bi-colored leaves (dark above, lighter beneath) are attractive features; fall color is yellow, with occasional red-purple. The trees can grow well in areas that are dry, poorly drained and wet, or even occasionally flooded, and they will tolerate significant soil compaction.



**Wildflower Packet:** Consists of a blend of flower seeds with 15-16 different annual and perennial species adapted for this area. Flowers will bloom from early spring into fall.

**Butterfly/Hummingbird Packet:** Each packet contains 10—13 annual and perennial varieties. This is designed to attract both butterfly and hummingbirds.
