Stress:

1. Stress falls on the last syllable in words with two syllables.
2. Otherwise, stress falls on the penultimate





syllable.

- Examples:

In my beautiful village = *Ur un ja'e klocceon a'olai*

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- The exclamation particle “*ya*” is used at the end of a sentence for emphasis.
- Examples:

I hate you! = Chol ja'e takeu ya!

What is that? = Hawa sa me?

Who do you love? = Hawai o chol aroho?

Declensions:

- There are no grammatical genders.
- There are two grammatical numbers, singular, and plural.
- There are no grammatical cases.
- Nouns decline according to number.
- There are no articles.





Object and Subject Particles:

- The object particle “*o*” can be added to emphasize the object of the sentence. It is only mandatory in imperative sentences and sentences with interrogative pronouns as the object.
- The subject particle “*il*” can be added to emphasize the subject of the sentence or to introduce a new topic. It is mandatory in sentences with unknown or indefinite subjects.
- Examples:

Bring light! = *Elo'ai o turat ya!*

Someone is here = *Ukai il keon me*

What have you done? = *Hawa o chol dewei'un?*

Singular and Plural:

	Singular	Plural
Suffix	- <i>'is</i>	- <i>'an</i>





- The standard form of some words is already plural, and the singular form is obtained by adding the suffix “-’is”.
- Examples:

Yeustai = *Animals*

Yeustai’is = *Animal*

Eloa’ai = *Friend*

Eloa’ai’an = *Friends*

Comparative and Superlative:

		Suffix
Comparative	More	-’in
	Less	-’un
Superlative	Most	-’ie
	Least	-’ua

- Most adjectives in comparative and superlative forms will receive a suffix according to the table above.





○ Examples:

Beautiful = *A'olai*

More beautiful = *A'olai'in*

Less beautiful = *A'olai'un*

The most beautiful = *A'olai'ie*

The least beautiful = *A'olai'ua*

- Personal pronouns as subjects cannot be omitted.
- The reflexive pronoun is used only with the third person.
- *When the possessor is obvious, the pronoun can be omitted. Example:

My mother is here = Un saha'un keon me

- The infinitive ending “*-n*” is removed before conjugating, except in the plural form. If the infinitive ending is “*-en*”, the ending will be removed entirely in the singular form.

Examples:

To be = Me'en

I am = Ja'e me

I am not = Ja'e mera

We are = Bul me'en

We are not = Bul me'enra

- Future and present tenses can be differentiated by adverbs or by context.





- Passive Voice is formed by conjugating the verb “*meleun*” (to turn) and the main verb in the participle form.
- *The imperative ending “-*t*” and “-*t’ra*” is used in informal contexts.
- Examples:

She does it / She will do it = *Ai si de*

She is doing it = *Ai si dewei*

She did it = *Ai si dewei’un*

She would do it = *Ai si delo*

Do it! (formal) = *Ai o dewei ya!*

Do it! (informal) = *Ai o det ya!*

It is done = *Ai de’ae meleu*

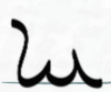
Writing System:

- *Tashba's* writing system is called "*Anlyeon sa*".
- It is an alphabet, in which each symbol represents a sound.
- It is written from left to right, then top to bottom.
- *The diacritics marked with * are used to represent "u" and "i" after a vowel, respectively.
- When a word begins in consonant, the first consonant will be written in its upper case form.







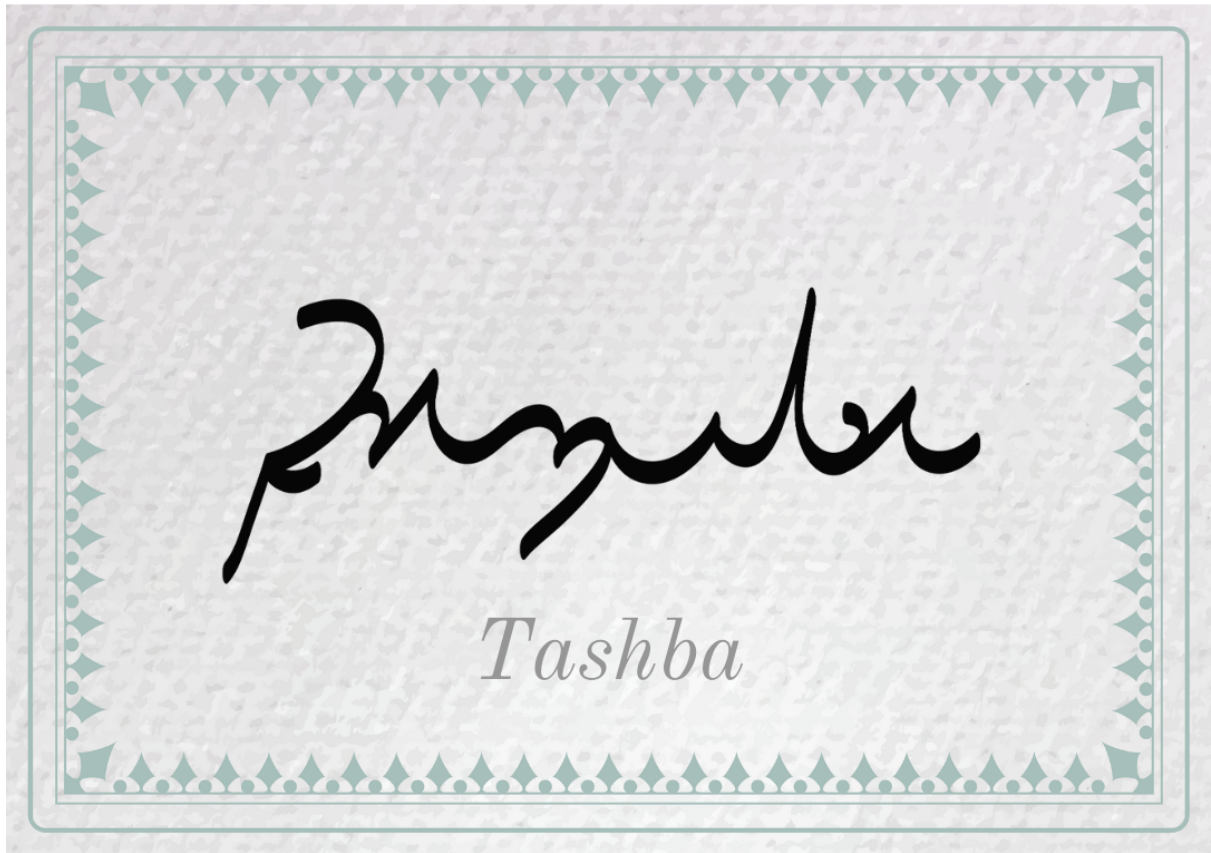
