Reethi Faru is a private boutique resort with an enviable pedigree for conserving the natural beauty of the islands and sustaining the ecosystems upon which the fragile coral reef relies.





GETTING TO US

Take a scenic 40-minute seaplane flight with a spectacular aerial view of the Maldivian thousand isles or alternatively take a 20-minute domestic flight to Dharavandhoo followed by a 40-minute speed boat ride to the island.

DELUXE TWO-BEDROOM BEACH SUITES



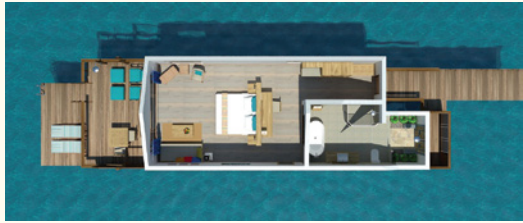

REETHI FARU WATERSPORTS CENTRE

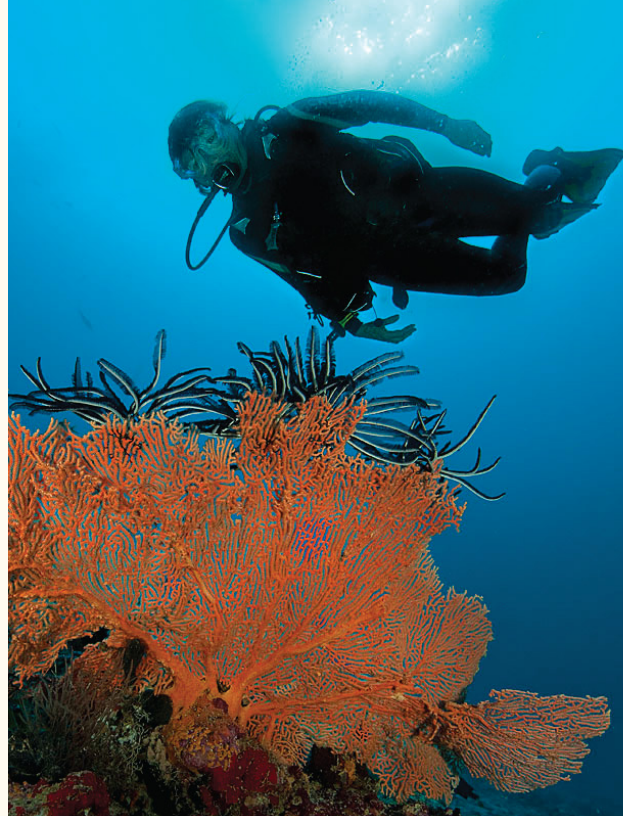
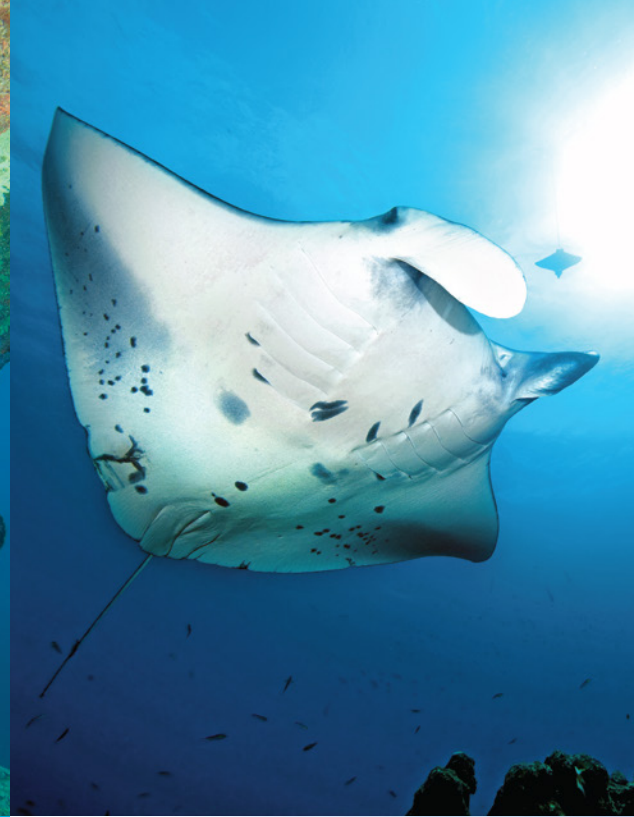

BIO-LUXURY AT REETHI FARU RESORT

Conservation through education helps us improve peoples' knowledge, behaviour, emotions and attitude towards conserving unique island-life and the environment. This can be done through various techniques that aid in reconnecting people with the natural world. In Reethi Faru Resort, we've adopted different methods to help the people understand the ecological importance and conservation of the marine and terrestrial world.

Solar energy

Installed capacity: 560 KW

Process: panels installed on roofs of staff accommodation/ back area buildings - the heat generated is converted to electrical energy through special inverters. The electrical energy is connected to the grid so we can use that energy to support about 80 villas. Overall 60% load of the whole island during day time is met by Solar installation and this energy is consumed immediately reducing our carbon footprint.

RO plant

Installed capacity: 3 plants of 150 cubic meter/day for domestic usage (bathing/cleaning/laundry) and 1 unit of 50 cubic meter/day for drinking water. Intake of plants are sea water, that is desalinated and converted into fresh water. We also have an energy recovery system which is inbuilt in the plants to reduce energy consumption. Reethi fen - our still and sparkling bottled water is produced in-house with strict quality control through these plants.

Waste water

Organically treated - all sewage water is treated on the island in our state-of-the-art sewage treatment plant. This is then used for gardening purposes and irrigation with the rest getting recycled back into the plant. The technology and process used has helped us to reduce at least 1 plant of 150 cubic meter/day which would have been necessary otherwise.

Heat exchangers

Hot water supply on the island is generated through heat exchangers which are tagged with the generators which produce enough heat to generate hot water. It reduces the islands' energy footprint making it one of the most energy efficient islands in the Maldives.

Bio gas plant

Food waste and horticulture waste are segregated from other waste and used to produce bio-gas which is being used for staff area kitchen for cooking purposes. All 100% waste that is generated is being recycled and the bio gas supplies all 3 meals that are served for 357 staff members.

LED lights

99% of lights around the island are LED as part of the resort's conservation plan.

Tree relocation

During construction, our team avoided cutting down trees and whichever were in the construction area were safely relocated. Mobilization of machinery which would harm corals in our lagoon were avoided and where required, they were relocated.

Buildings

A combination of soil stabilized earthen blocks and aerated cement blocks were used in creating our buildings. Both these materials are eco-friendly, functioning as natural heat insulators and help keep the carbon footprint as low as possible.

Air conditioning

All air-conditioners on the island are non-CFC. The refrigerant gas (cooling gas) is eco- friendly with a non-CFC component

Waste management

Plastic, glass, metal, paper, cardboard, wood is all recycled on the island.

Plastic management

RFR is working in collaboration with Parley for the oceans to manage the plastic waste on the island and to avoid and intercept their entry into the marine eco systems.

MARINE CONSERVATION REETHI FARU RESORT

At Reethi Faru Resort, we believe in conserving what is naturally available to us; the ocean and all that it represents and our beautiful island that is lush with vegetation. Reethi Faru literally translates to “beautiful reef”, which is why we are mindful of keeping our beach, and ultimately our reef and lagoon clean and free of any rubbish. Reethi Faru is unique in a way that it is one of the very few inhabited islands in the Maldives that has the reef surrounding the whole island. Corals are the building blocks of the reef and they are under tremendous threat and their conservation is imperative.

The resident marine biologist has been monitoring the reef health, biodiversity, and abundance of the marine micro and mega fauna, since the construction phase of the island and continues to do so. Climate change has in fact affected the reefs globally, and the Maldives is no exception. The globally rising temperature in the atmosphere is in turn raising the temperatures of the water. This is causing the reefs from all over the world to lose their colour by losing symbiotic algae.

We are installing artificial reefs to boost the growth of the depleting corals around the island. This also was started during the construction phase and is still being done - and it is also used as an educational activity for the guests.

At Reethi Faru, we are aware of the importance of conserving the natural environment and strive to do so every day. From construction - marine environment taken into consideration; when beams were being set up for the water villas and jetties, coral were relocated around the house reef and not destroyed or damaged. The turquoise blue waters of the Maldives are one of the main attractions of the nation, which brings in millions of people from all over the world. Therefore, it is imperative to protect and preserve the marine ecosystems and all its inhabitants, so that the future generations can appreciate the same benefits that we enjoy today. Reethi Faru Management is deeply committed to this cause.

Artificial reefs

Set up during construction phase to help boost the growth of coral reefs around the island. More nurseries are being set up around the island in the shallow and deep end of the house reef. After 2016 El Nino, most coral reefs were affected in and around Maldives. Artificial reefs are a way to restore the reefs which is one of our main initiatives in the resort. So far, we have been seeing a lot of recovery and regeneration of corals around the house reef and artificial reef. Conservation of coral reefs is imperative to show presence and survival of other marine life; sharks are sign of a healthy reef and at Reethi Faru resort we have various species of friendly sharks present which in turn has a positive impact on other fish in the reef.

House reef

Most common sightings will be curious turtles, eagle rays, sharks, dolphins and schools of fish all around.

Marine life

Marine conservation efforts for certain megafauna species are also being done by working in collaboration with Manta Trust and Olive Ridley project for manta rays and turtles respectively.

Dolphin tracking

Newest project being tried and tested. This is to try to understand the movement patterns within Raa Atoll and study their behaviour.

Reethi Day

At Reethi Faru, we are mindful of protecting our environment, both marine and terrestrial. That is how our monthly “Reethi Day” (Translates to Beautiful Day) initiative began, which is a day to celebrate the environment and help conserve it through education and activities with the whole team. Even guests take part in coral planting, reef clean-ups, beach clean-ups, tree planting, educational presentations, guided awareness snorkels and more on the monthly Reethi Day!
