Expanded Quantity Charts



The official IASF quantity charts cover standard IASF team sizes.

Revolution's Expanded Quantity Chart adds ranges for the smaller and larger team sizes offered within the UK, as per the SCUUK Age Grid.

The expanded chart covers:

- **Stunt and pyramid group quantities**
- **Toss quantities for Levels 2–7**
- **Tumbling and jump Majority and Most counts**

The expanded chart is designed for use alongside the IASF comparative scoring system.

It is a Revolution adaptation and is not an official IASF document.

2026-27 Cheer Scoring COACH QUICK GUIDE *Prep*



Revolution's Prep scoring system is based on the IASF comparative format but has been adapted to provide an appropriate developmental pathway between Novice and Elite.

Prep teams will be scored out of 91 points.

Key Prep Division Details

- Stunt difficulty is worth a maximum of 10 points.
- The highest stunt range requires a majority of the team to perform three or more level-appropriate skills.
- The highest pyramid range requires a minimum of three level-appropriate skills and two structures.
- Jump difficulty is based on two advanced jumps.
- Building, tumbling, jumps, dance and overall performance are assessed comparatively within division.
- Revolution's Expanded Quantity Chart applies to team-majority requirements.
- Teams will be ranked within their division using their final competition score as a percentage.
- These adaptations are intended to reward strong Prep-level routines without requiring teams to perform an Elite-style quantity or difficulty of skills.

Novice is a developmental and introductory division. Teams are assessed on the quality and execution of their routine rather than being rewarded for increased difficulty.

Novice teams will be scored out of 60 points, awarded a rating, and will not be ranked against one another, nor will division standings be released to coaches.

Key U8-U16 Novice Division Details

- Stunt, pyramid, tumbling and jump difficulty are not scored. Quantity charts are therefore not required for Novice.
- Stunt technique, pyramid technique, standing tumbling technique, running tumbling technique, jump technique, dance difficulty, dance technique, routine creativity and composition, formations and transitions and performance will be scored in an appropriately adapted rubric.
- Novice teams may perform only the skills permitted under the applicable SportCheer UK and IASF rules. Performing an unscored skill does not prevent a deduction being applied if that skill is illegal or performed outside the division restrictions.
- Novice ratings will be awarded based on the following final percentages:

Superior = 75% and above

Excellent = 50%–74.9%

Outstanding = Below 50%

Novice is a developmental and introductory division. Teams are assessed on the quality and execution of their routine rather than being rewarded for increased difficulty.

Novice teams will be scored out of 60 points, awarded a rating, and will not be ranked against one another, nor will division standings be released to coaches.

Key U6 Novice Division Details

- Stunt, pyramid, tumbling and jump difficulty, as well as stunt and pyramid technique are not scored. Quantity charts are therefore not required for Novice.
- Standing tumbling technique, running tumbling technique, jump technique, dance difficulty, dance technique, routine creativity and composition, formations and transitions and performance will be scored in an appropriately adapted rubric.
- Novice teams may perform only the skills permitted under the applicable SportCheer UK Age Grid and IASF rules. Performing an unscored skill does not prevent a deduction being applied if that skill is illegal or performed outside the division restrictions.
- Novice ratings will be awarded based on the following final percentages:

Superior = 75% and above

Excellent = 50%–74.9%

Outstanding = Below 50%
