- 100% Cotton
- 300 gsm (140 lb) minimum; 640 gsm (300 lb) preferred

Surface Types:

- **Hot Pressed**: Not ideal for watercolor; good for tempera or mixed-media. The surface is smooth.
- Cold Pressed: Slightly textured surface, ideal for most watercolor techniques.
- Rough: Heavily textured; offers expressive brushwork and granulation effects.

- Sheets: Versatile and great for custom sizing
- Blocks: Pre-stretched, glued on all sides convenient for painting without taping
- Pads: Economical, good for practice
- Rolls: Ideal for large-scale work or custom cutting

Watercolor Brushes

Types & Sizes:

• Natural Round: Sizes 1, 2, 4

• Synthetic Round: Sizes 2, 7, 8, 10

• Angled: Sizes 6, 8, 10

• Rigger or Liner: For detail work

Brush Notes:

Brushes come in natural (usually sable - excellent water retention and softness) and synthetic (affordable, durable, and animal-friendly) types. Many synthetic options now closely mimic natural hair performance.

Note: Avoid long-handled brushes - they are meant for oil/acrylic painting and not suitable for watercolor.

Watercolor Palette

- Large mixing area
- Ceramic, porcelain, or enameled metal preferred (non-staining)
- Travel palettes available with pans

Water Containers

• At least two: one for clean water, one for rinsing

Masking Supplies

• Masking fluid (Winsor & Newton or Pebeo)

Drawing & Sketching Tools

- HB or 2HB Pencil
- Kneaded Eraser

Miscellaneous

- **Spray Bottle**: Use a fine mist bottle it should spray water like a soft powder mist, great for keeping paints moist or creating texture.
- **Mounting Board & Paper Tape**: If using loose sheets (not blocks), use a sturdy board (like gatorboard or wood) and paper/artist tape to secure and stretch the paper.
- **Sketchbook**: Optional, for planning and fieldwork
