How do I find out if my child has special needs?

Wondering if your child has special needs? As the parent you are able to request that an evaluation is done to determine your child's needs for special education and/or related services. Your child's eligibility to get a range of services is determined by the evaluation and will cover all areas related to the disability that you suspect; it also must be conducted by a trained and knowledgeable individual. This evaluation must also be offered in your child's native language and will be done at no cost to you. If you disagree with this evaluation, you have the right to take your child to an Independent Education Evaluation (IEE) and you are able to request that the school pay for it.
