

Mironova Classical Ballet Academy Student Agreement

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General:

- Learning ballet requires commitment and dedication. In order to improve and practice safely, students must attend class consistently. Studying at a proper level is imperative to ensure progress. Level assignment decisions must be respected.
- Students should not attend class when ill, and return only when symptoms have subsided in order to prevent the spread of germs to other students and teachers.
- Ballet is a physical activity that involves a risk of injury. We take every measure to protect our students from injuries. However, Mironova Classical Ballet Academy (MCBA) shall not be held liable for any injuries occurred during class or rehearsal.
- MCBA reserves a right to use photos of your child taken in class, rehearsal and the performance for its promotion materials unless specifically requested by parents.
- Parents are not allowed in the classroom. Taking photos and videos are prohibited.

Tuition:

- Tuition is non-refundable. Payment is due on the first calendar day of the semester or the month. We charge \$25 for late payment after the 10th calendar day, and \$30 for a returned check.
- There is no credit for school closure dates specified in the annual calendar or missed classes due to personal reasons (vacations, illness, short-term injuries, lack of transportation, etc.) Students are allowed to make up for missed classes during the same month, at their current or lower level (approval needed for higher level).
- We do not prorate monthly tuition for missed classes except for enrolling for the first time in mid-month.
- MCBA offers 2 payment options; 5 month advance payment with 10% discount, and monthly payment. The 5% family discount is also available (can be combined).
- Changing a program mid-semester is not allowed unless it's recommended by Director.
- MCBA accepts Zelle, check and cash. Please note the student name, level, and month of the tuition, the amount on the envelope if paying cash, for all payments.
- Itemized receipts (one receipt per payment or one receipt for all payments for the year) are available upon request. We do not customize descriptions.

Student code of conduct:

- Students must be respectful to teachers and fellow students at all times. They must listen to instructions in silence and focus on the learning.
- Insults, swearing, fighting, etc. will not be tolerated. Repeated disruptive behavior will be grounds for dismissal from class or expulsion from the school.
- Students are required to wear uniform specified by level, and wear a neat bun. No baggy clothes and loose hair are permitted in class.
- Our dress code also includes no visible underwear, no dirty tights, and no holes in shoes and tights. Students are expected to keep themselves clean and tidy.
- Students should take good care of the property, and not enter the area of the building where it is not permitted.
