Odds & Ends:

For information on **leaf burning**, please **call 449-7561** for the **Health Dept** or **449-3000** for the **Sheriff**. If you must burn, please be considerate of others. For many, smoke is not only an irritant, but also a health concern. Current guidelines dictate no burning before 8:00 am and nothing added after 5:30 pm.

Street snow removal will occur on snow accumulations of 2" or greater. Please do not park on the street when <u>any</u> snowfall is expected.

Having been satisfied with the service provided, the Board has approved the continuance of the contract with the past year's snow removal contractor.

The postal service reminds us to please keep a clear path to mail box stations for our mail carrier. When **boxes are blocked** by excessive snow, **mail will not be delivered** to that mail box station.

Please remove any obstacles and obstructions from the common areas when not in use. These items are impediments to the area maintenance and also present a liability for the association. Your cooperation is appreciated.

Periodically the Board seeks quotes for various services. During this year's 'off season', the Board is accepting quotes from lawn care contractors for the cutting of grass in three Association common areas. If you know of a reliable and insured contractor willing to provide this service to the Association, have them contact a Board member by phone or via the Association website. The Board will provide a description of the task and a map of the three areas. Each of the three areas has a particular need and challenge, so it is advised the contractor receive the 'scope of work' document to submit a complete and accurate quote.

Leaf pickup service is available:

Turf Care is offering leaf pick up service for Oak Crossing residents. The fee is \$40 per time. Pickups will be Nov 8-9 and Dec 14-15. For more information and to sign up for the service, please call Turf Care at 260-415-7800 or email Judy Holley at J.Holley@turfcarelawns.com.

Be careful and safe:

The entrance to the subdivision from Dupont Road (south entrance) has become a hazard for people, property, and wildlife. Please reduce speed to a maximum 15 mph to avoid collisions. This will be especially necessary as roads become slick with wet leaves, snow, and ice. Several near collisions with cars, and many fatal collisions with wildlife have occurred at the entrance curve. You're so close to home, please don't let the trip end prematurely or tragically. Be careful, courteous, and safe.
