Please do not place leaf piles in the street. This is a safety concern (for children and items hiding in the pile) and causes street drains and systems to malfunction. Please do not dispose of yard waste in common areas, as this prevents proper maintenance and also finds its way into the street drainage system. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated.

Odds & Ends:

For information on **leaf burning**, please **call 449-7459** for the **Health Dept** or **449-7535** for the **Sheriff**. If you must burn, please be considerate of others. For many, smoke is not only an irritant, but a serious health issue. Current County guidelines dictate no burning before 8:00 am and nothing added after 5:30 pm.

Street snow removal will occur on snow accumulations of 2" or greater. **Do not park on the street when ANY snowfall is expected.**

The postal service reminds us to keep clear access to mail box stations for our mail carrier. When **boxes are blocked** by vehicles or snow, **mail will not be delivered** to that mail box station.

For those with a fence, it is **your duty to maintain your yard**, regardless of the fence boundary. Unsure of your lot line? ...info is available at the County GIS website, or ask us.
