Eligibility

- A candidate that has graduated or is on track to graduate from any Central Indiana high school.
- Candidate must have a passion for or a plan to accomplish their business dream.
- Candidate must aspire to enter a trade, vocation or starting, owning or growing a business.

Criteria

- The candidate will submit a plan of what he or she wants to accomplish to reach their goals.
- The plan must detail how he or she will use both the financial gift and the network connections provided.
- The candidate must request a specific financial gift that includes information/documents to support the amount requested.
- The candidate will provide two non-parental/guardian adults who will vouch for their character, drive, integrity and ambition.
- The candidate must be willing to meet with their mentor on a regular basis to stay on track and to assist with any obstacles assuring the journey to reaching their goal is successful.

Procedure

- The online application must be submitted by March 1, 2024.
- All application questions must be answered completely.
- Two reference names (other than relatives) and phone numbers must be submitted with the application.
- Finalists must submit a copy of high school transcript and/or proof of graduation.
- Finalists will be interviewed by the JoJo's Jumpstart Foundation Board of Directors
