


The Pastor Nominating Committee (PNC) has been meeting weekly and diligently working to identify the right candidate for our church's pastoral position. The Presbytery Leadership Committee approved our Ministry Discernment Profile, which has been available online since December. We have been actively monitoring it for potential applicants.

Our committee crafted a comprehensive job posting announcement which was approved by our General Presbyter, Rev. Dr. Matt Meinke. This was subsequently posted on various platforms, including the National Presbyterian Church website, churchjobsonline.com, ChristianCareerCenter.com, PastorJobs.net, Indeed, LinkedIn, Glassdoor, ZipRecruiter, and more. Additionally, we are currently in the process of posting the position on different seminary job boards locally and nationally, broadening our reach to potential candidates.

Joel Youkers, our Maumee Valley Presbytery Leadership Committee liaison, joined us in February and suggested exploring the option of a shared pastor. Since then, our committee has actively pursued this idea by reaching out to several churches.

Throughout this process, your prayers and support have been invaluable. We kindly ask for your continued prayers for God's will and wisdom in guiding us to the individual prepared for this responsibility. The PNC deeply appreciates your support and patience during this transitional period. Thank you, and may God's guidance be with us.

YOUR PASTOR'S WELL-CAFFEINATED COMMENTS

Greetings!

Grace and peace to you from God our Father and our Lord Jesus Christ.

I've learned quite a few things about this calling the last few months.

• Preaching every Sunday is a lot different than preaching occasionally. I used to find out a month or more ahead of time when I would be preaching, so I'd have a lot of time to think about the Scripture. Now I have a week. I have needed to work out what I needed each week to get from Monday to Sunday. I was reminded of the pastor who told me he had a sign on his desk that said: "Monday—Read the Scriptures for next Sunday. Tuesday—Read the Scriptures for next Sunday. Wednesday—" and so on.



- Like you, I've heard the same preacher for the last 13 years, and I found my first sermons were fitting into the patterns that Tom had. Going to the Calvin Institute of Christian Worship really helped me think about how I was preaching, what I needed to know before I should start writing, and how I could use different structures for my sermons. I hope I continue to improve as I get more practice.
- Writing services is hard! Like Tom did, I am trying to write my services several weeks ahead of time. The hardest part to craft is the pastoral prayers, because I am praying on behalf of the church sometime in the future in a way that reflects the worship and the church weeks before I've written the sermon. If you come to church and see me pacing in the sanctuary or sitting in the front pew, you will know what I am doing.

I am honored to be asked to do two things this summer:

- I will be the Head Spiritual Director for the Bryan Boys Awakening Friday July 19th—Sunday July 21st at Camp Palmer. I have been involved with the Great Banquet for many years, and this is the first time I've been a spiritual director in quite a while—I've been a speaker, a table leader, a kitchen team members, and an Agape team member (they take care of all the behind the scene details). You can learn more at bryanawakening.org.
- I will be a counselor at Camp Rejoice at Kirkmont. If you remember, I helped with the presbytery youth retreat at Kirkmont last year, and that led to a invite to help this year. Camp Rejoice is from Sunday, July 7th to Saturday, July 13th. More information can be found at kirkmontcetner.org/summer-camps.

Though I do not know how long I will be serving as your pastor, I cannot tell you how honored I am to be serving the church where I has baptized, where I grew up, where I was ordained as a deacon and ordained as a minister, where I was prayed for through the toughest parts of my life, and where I have always felt at home. I pray I will be as much of a blessing to you as you have been to me.

Here's my prayer challenge to you:

Pick something from the fruit of the Spirit In Galatians 5:22-23, like "love" or "joy" or "patience" or "kindness", or maybe something like "grace" or "peace" or "faith", and pray the church has more of it and shows more of it. Use holy imagination to ponder what that would be like.






January is higher because some members pay yearly or quarterly.

If you wish to reimburse the church for the book, the cost is \$10.


Easter Egg Hunt
