All glossy surfaces should be lightly sanded before applying Acoustical Ceiling Tile Paint. Metal tracks subject to rusting should be primed with a premium quality rust preventive primer. WARNING! Application:

DO NOT USE ADDITIVES IN THIS PRODUCT! Keenan Acoustical Ceiling Tile Paint is formulated for ideal performance. Any additions to it will hurt its performance. Stir thoroughly. Designed for spray application, using an airless sprayer at a pressure only high enough to achieve a solid spray fan and using a 0.013-0.017 spray tip. It should be applied at 1-mil wet, with 50% overlap. Follow equipment manufacturer's instructions for proper use. Apply only when surface and air temperature are greater than 50°F and less than 95°F.

White. Can be tinted with maximum 2oz. of universal colorants per gallon. This product is not controlled as a finting base, so final color may vary.

Coverage:

On flat acoustical tiles, coverage is approximately 300 sq. ft. per gallon (less on extremely textured porous tiles). Spread rate will also be affected by the application method and thinning of the paint.

Dry Time:

Tack free: 30 minutes; Recoat: 4-hours; Full cure: 7 days. High humidity and low temperature will prolong dry time.

Clean-up:

Wash tools and equipment immediately with soap and warm water.

Thinning:

Thinning is not required, but up to 1/2 pint of water per gallon of paint may be added.

Flash Point:

None, water-based paint.

N.F.P.A. Class "A" on non-combustible surfaces.

V.O.C. (V.O.S):

This product contains less than 25 grams VOC/VOS per liter of coating (0.21 lbs. per gallon).
